"Cyclopropanecarboxylic Acid Esters."

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim I which reads as follows:—

1. A cyclopropanecarboxylio acid esters having the general formula.—

where in X^1 , X^2 , X^3 , and X^4 each means a member selected from the group consisting of hydrogen and halogen atoms, and methyl and acetoxy radicals; Z is a member of oxygen and sulfur atoms; F means a double bond at any position of the cyclohexane nucleus, and R is a member selected from methyl and methoxycarbonyl radicals.

There are 8 claims and 30 examples.
