#### MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, July 14, 1899, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated July 7, 1899.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairmau; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Dr. Allan Perry; Mr. H. T. S. Ward; the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; and Mr. H. A. Jayawardene.

The Minutes of June 9, 1899, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of June 9, 1899, be confirmed.

 Pursuant to notice, the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna asked—How often the sluice gate under Madampitiya bridge was closed after its construction, and moved for papers. Mr. C. Perera seconded.

The Chairman having replied that the sluice gate had not been closed since its construction, the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna thereupon moved "that the matter be referred to the Director of Public Works."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried unanimously.

Pursuant to notice, the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna moved "that the portions of Blomendahl road, which

are periodically submerged, be raised above ordinary flood level.

By leave of Council the motion was amended as follows: -" That it is desirable that the portions of Blomendahl road, which are periodically submerged, should be aiserd above ordinary flood level, and that an estimate be called for.'

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. Perera.

Whereupon the motion as amended was carried.

3. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera moved "that it be considered what steps are necessary to be taken to put the roads within the Municipality in thoroughly good order, especially the roads on the tramway routes, and moved for papers with the complaints and reports relating to the subject from the commencement of the current year."

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.

The papers were laid on the table, whereupon Mr. C. Perera moved "that a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, Mr. H. T. S. Ward, the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. Perera Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, and Mr. R. H. Morgan—three Members to form a quorum—be appointed to inquire and the control of the con report upon the steps to be taken to facilitate the obtaining of metal and the maintenance of roads in good repair, and for laying down rules for the guidance of the tramway and Municipal officers for obviating inconvenience and danger to passengers and vehicular traffic during the course of any repairs and construction that may become necessary.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried unanimously.

- 4. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy's motion, with regard to the action of the Inspector-General of Police in preventing carriage traffic in Prince street, Fort, between 5 and 6 P.M. on Sundays, was deferred for the next Meeting of Council.
- Pursuant to notice, Mr. A. Alvis moved "that those portions of the Sanitary Officer's report for the first quarter of 1899, which relate to the scavenging of the town and the watering of the streets, be considered, and that effect be given to rule 4 adopted by the Municipal Council on March 7, 1877.'

By leave of Council the motion was amended as follows: -- "That the scavenging be placed under the control

and supervision of the Sanitary Officer.

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. Perera and carried unanimously.

6. The following recommendation from the Standing Committee of June 16, 1899, was laid before Council :-

June 16, 1899.

14. Edinburgh fruit and vegetable market.

Resolved that the Council be advised to continue the existing arrangements during the rest of the year.

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene moved the adoption of the foregoing recommendation of the Standing Committee.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried unanimously.

The following recommendation from the Standing Committee, with regard to the application from Messrs. Boustead Brothers for permission to run steam launches on the Colombo lake and to erect landing stages at different points, was laid before Council:—

Business.

(1) Application from Messrs. Boustead Brothers for permission to run steam launches on the Colombo lake and to erect landing stages at different points.

Orders.

- (1) Resolved that the Council be advised to allow the application, subject to the following conditions:—
  - (1) The scale of fares to be approved by the Chairman.

The speeds of transit to be approved by the Chairman.

The hours of running and time table to be approved by the Chairman.

(4) The form of launch used to be approved by the Chairman.

(5) The site, design and construction of landing stages to be approved by the Chairman.
(6) Launches not to emit smoke or steam within 50 ft. of a bridge. Nothing to be one upon a launch likely to inconvenience traffic on a bridge.

(7) Side lights and head light to be carried from sunset to sunrise.

The rules of the road at sea to be observed in the management of launches.

(9) The condition of the lake being subject to causes beyond the control of the Council, no claim of any kind to be preferred against the Council should the running of the launches be impeded, rendered difficult, or suspended; or should any accident or injury to the launches or any property of the proprietors occur from any cause whatever.

(10) The use of steam whistles to be forbidden, except in case of emergency to avoid accidents.
(11) Any offence against conditions 6, 7, 8, or 10 to be punishable with a fine not exceeding Rs. 100 for each offence, at the discretion of the Chairman. If such fine is not promptly paid, then the Chairman may suspend and completely stop the service for such period as he thinks fit, and shall have power to take any steps he may think fit to enforce his order for suspension of the service.

(12) A payment of Rs. 5 per month to be made to the Municipal Council for each landing stage

ordinarily used for the accommodation of the general public.

(13) If a landing stage is abaudoned, all the materials to be removed. All piles, walls, &c., to be taken up and the site to be restored to the same condition in which it was before the landing stage was put up.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the foregoing recommendation of the Standing Committee be amended by the substitution of the word "Council" for the word "Chairman" in conditions 1, 2, and 3, and that the recommendation so amended be adopted."

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried unanimously.

8. A report dated June 30, 1899, of the Special Committee on lighting, on the subject of electric lighting the tramway routes, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved the adoption of the report. Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.

9. The revised by-laws, as drafted by the Special Committee appointed for the purpose, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the revised by-laws as drafted by the Special Committee be remitted to that

Committee for the purpose of inserting the penalty clauses.

Dr. A. Perry seconded.—Carried unanimously.

10. A letter No. 51/010179, dated June 21, 1899, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the resolution of the Council of June 9, 1899, on the subject of the duplication of the water main throughout its entire length. was read.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the matter be deferred for the next Meeting of Council.

The Hon. Mr. A. de A. Senaviratna seconded.—Carried unanimously.

- A notification from the Chairman that Mr. Stanley Bois and Mr. F. H. Grinlinton have vacated their seats as Members of Council by absence from three consecutive General Meetings was laid on the table.
- 12. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to June 30, 1899, and a Progress Report of work done for June, 1899, were laid on the table.
