

" Intra-uterine device"

Abstract.—The intrauterine device consists of an elongated flexible material in the shape of a large 'S' continuing into a smaller 'S'. This device is capable of being substantially straightened out. It returns to the previous double 'S' curved shape when released.

It is made of tesion synthetic plastic material which is inert and does not produce any harmful reaction to the wearer.

The device has about 20% by volume of barium sulphate mixed with the plastic material to render the resistent device molded therefrom, visible to X'ray examination. It has a flexible body tail connected to the end of the flexible body at the end of the short 'S'.

The device is inserted inside the uterus by means of a flexible sleeve or tube with a slidable plunger. The tube and the plunger also made from Teflon. The device may be left within the uterus for months or years and will remain in its operative position during such time. In case it is desired to remove the device this is readily accomplished by grasping the free end of the tail with a suitable instrument such as a forceps, and thereafter pulling the device outwardly of the uterus.
