- (2) No extension after thirty days shall be granted by the Secretary without the prior approval of the Commission, but in a case where an extension is required on the ground of sudden illness or any other ground of urgency, the Secretary may grant an extension for such period as he may require to consult the Commission and obtain its sanction.

This is an award under section 17 (i) of the Industrial Disputes Act. By Order made under section 4 (i) of the Industrial Disputes Act, the Honourable the Minister of Labour and Social Services referred this dispute to this tribunal for settlement by arbitration. The statement of the matter in dispute of the Commissioner of Labour accompanying the Honourable Minister's Order gives the matter in dispute in the following terms:—

"The matter in dispute between the Democratic Workers Congress of the one part and Mr. W. S. W. Peiris, Mr. W. T. de Alwis, Mrs. R. S. Perera, Mrs. W. Ellen Perera, Mr. W. H. de Alwis, Mrs. W. P. de Perera, Mrs. W. M. L. de Alwis and Mrs. W. P. M. Perera, the co-owners of Welimaluwa Estate, Ratnapura, of the other part, is whether the termination of employment of the following workers is justified and to what relief each of them is entitled:—

1. M. Duraisamy
2. Sinnapillai, w/o. Duraisamy,
3. D. Muniandy,
4. D. Balasubramanyam.

When this dispute was taken up for inquiry on the 24th June and 9th July, 1965, Mr. Motha appeared for the applicant Union and Mr. L. Gunasekera appeared on behalf of the co-owners. The parties came to an amicable settlement on a suggestion made by the tribunal. The terms of settlement were as follows:—

- (1) Mr. Shirley de Peiris, the Superintendent of the estate, on behalf of the co-owners of Welimaluwa estate offered a sum of Rs. 600 as an ex-gratia payment to all the workers, namely, M. Duraisamy, Sillapulle, wife of Duraisamy, D. Muniandy, and D. Balasubramanyam.
- (2) The Union accepted this sum on behalf of the workers in full and final satisfaction of all the claims of the workers against the respondents;
- (3) This sum of Rs. 600 was tendered to the workers before this tribunal.

I approve the above terms of settlement and make order accordingly.

**THE INDUSTRIAL DISPUTES ACT, CHAPTER 131**

THE Award transmitted to me by the President, Labour Tribunal VI, to whom the industrial dispute which had arisen between the Lanka Estate Workers' Union, 47, Jayantha Weerasekera Mawatha, Colombo 10, and Mr. U. L. M.
