EXPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 3/66

Export of Coir Fibre

REFERENCE Export Control Notice No. 2/65 of 20th September, 1965, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 14,513 of 24th September, 1965, and Export Control Notice No. 1/66 of 11th January, 1966, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,632 of 11th January, 1966, the classification of Coir Fibre is hereby amended.

2. The new Classification of Coir Fibre and the prices mentioned in the Schedule below will be effective from today and will remain in force until further notice.

3. No export licences will be issued unless the F.O.B. & C.I.F. prices are consistent with the floor prices.

4. All shippers are hereby notified that all contracts for the export of fibre entered into prior to the date of this notification, should be registered with this Control before 3 p.m. on 9.3.66.
