Export of Coir Fibre

REFERENCE Export Control Notice No. 2/65 of 20th September, 1965, published in Ceylon Government Gazette No. 14,513 of 24th September, 1965, and Export Control Notice No. 1/66 of 11th January, 1966, published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 14,632 of 11th January, 1966, the classification of Coir Fibre is hereby amended.
