THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ACT

The Order made under section 44 of the Exchange Control Act (Chapter 423) and published in Gazette No. 12,338 of April 7, 1961, as last amended by Order published in Gazette No. 13,992 of March 20, 1964, is hereby further amended, in paragraph 3 thereof, by the addition immediately after sub-paragraph (9) of the following new sub-paragraph:—

"(10) the taking out of Ceylon, at any one time, by any female person ordinarily resident in Ceylon and proceeding abroad temporarily, of jowellery, being jewellery which belongs to that person and is customerily worn by that person as part of a religious tradition, in such quantity and of such value as may be authorised by the Collector in his absolute discretion provided that the value of such jewellery, and of any jewellery as may be permitted to be taken under sub-paragraph (7), does not exceed Rs. 2,000 in the aggregate in respect of each female passenger."

Food Price Order No. C. 402.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

Subsidiary Foodstuffs

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Pinnaduwage Arthur Silva, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect Food Price Order No. C. 401 dated September 28,1965, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 14,516 of September 29, 1965;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be an Importers' maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross, a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross, and a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett, to a consumer, respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the Municipal Limits of the town of Colombo;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule, less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article:

- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such articles fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer:
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any articles specified in column 1 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of such articles sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2, 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.
