IT is hereby notified for the purpose of the application of the Order under section 2 of the Revenue Protection Act, No. 19 of 1962, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,138 of 8th August, 1964, and ratified by the House of Representatives on 16.10.1964, that the estimated c.i.f. price of Philippines copra in the London Market for the week commencing on Monday, the 22nd November, 1965, is \$ 219.
