#### Price Orders

Food Price Order No. C. 403.

SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS.

#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

##### Order

By virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, (Chapter 173), I, Pinnawilage Arthur Silva, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect Food Price Order No. C. 402 dated November 16, 1965, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,559 of November 17, 1965;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be an Importer's maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross, a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer, respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the Municipal Limits of the town of Colombo;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule, less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any articles specified in column 1 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the quantity of such articles sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2, 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.

Food Price Order No. BT/2/65 WHITE REFINED SUGAR

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT  
Order

BY virtue of powers vested in me by Section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, (Chapter 173) I, Peethamparam Kasilingam, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for Batticaloa District do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. BT/3/63 dated March 2, 1963, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 13,556 of March 8, 1963;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect, the prices specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross above which White Refined Sugar shall not be sold within the areas mentioned with in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the First Schedule hereto;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which White Refined Sugar shall not be sold within the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of White Refined Sugar for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of any quantity of White Refined Sugar in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of White Refined Sugar less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) White Refined Sugar shall exclude all forms of Jaggery;
- (v) direct that in every area where the maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell White Refined Sugar which is adulterated with any other article; or with sugar of any inferior grade or quality;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who has White Refined Sugar in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of White Refined Sugar in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for the White Refined Sugar fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the White Refined Sugar and the Maximum prices could be clearly seen by any consumer;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells White Refined Sugar by wholesale and every person who sells White Refined Sugar by retail shall give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of White Refined Sugar sold (by weight);

(c) the price paid for the quantity of White Refined Sugar sold;

(d) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;

(ix) direct that when White Refined Sugar is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which White Refined Sugar is sold;
