##### Notification

SPECIAL ALLOWANCES PAYABLE TO WORKERS IN THE TEA GROWING AND MANUFACTURING, THE RUBBER GROWING AND MANUFACTURING, THE COCOA, CARDAMOM AND PEPPER GROWING AND MANUFACTURING, THE COCONUT GROWING, THE COCONUT MANUFACTURING, THE PLUMBAGO, THE ENGINEERING, THE PRINTING, THE MOTOR TRANSPORT, THE TEA EXPORT, THE RUBBER EXPORT, THE MATCH MANUFACTURING, THE CINEMA, THE DOCK, HARBOUR AND PORT TRANSPORT, THE BUILDING, THE BAKING, THE BRICK AND TILE MANUFACTURING, THE COIR MATTRESS AND BRISTLE FIBRE EXPORT AND THE ICE AND AERATED WATERS MANUFACTURING TRADES.
