The Resthouse Act

RULES in respect of the resthouse at Vavuniya made under section 4 of the Resthouse Act (Chapter 275), by the Vavuniya Urban Council, the appropriate authority in that behalf, and approved by the M.nister of Local Government by virtue of the powers vested in him by that section.

RULES

1. (1) An occupation fee and charges at the rates set out in the Schedule hereto shall be paid by every person using or occupying any part of the Resthouse.

(2) No fee shall be charged in respect of the following:-----(a) an infant in arms:

(b) a servant who is in attendance on a visitor at the resthouse, and who sleeps in the car or in the garage; and

(c) the chauffeur of any car garaged in the resthouse premises, if he sleeps in the car or in the garage.

2. (1) Every visitor shall, on his admission to the resthouse, write his name and address legibly in the resthouse visitor's book.

(2) No visitor shall occupy any part of the resthouse or be supplied with refreshments until he has complied with the requirements of the preceding paragraph.

3. (1) No person shall occupy any part of the resthouse for more than three consecutive days without the written permission c_{1}^{4} the off the security of the Chairman.

(2) Every occupier of the resthouse who has not obtained permission as aforesaid shall, on the expiration of three days, leave the resthouse.

4. All charges paid by a visitor shall be entered by the resthouse-keeper in the register kept for the purpose.

5. The resthouse charges payable by a visitor shall be paid in cash on demand, and in default of such payment, the resthouse-keeper shall be entitled to refuse further supplies to such visitor.

6. (1) No room shall be reserved for any visitor prior to his arrival unless it is engaged at least one day in advance.

(2) Where a room is reserved in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this rule, it shall be paid for, even if the person engaging it does not occupy it.

(3) Until the arrival of the person or persons for whom a room is reserved, such room shall be at the disposal of any other person requiring, it.

7. The resthouse keeper shall not be bound to comply with any telegram requesting meals to be prepared unless the name and address of the sender are set out in the telegram.

8. No bed, sofa or couch in the resthouse shall be used for the purpose of s'eeping unless a sheet is spread thereon.

9. The value of all articles damaged or broken by a visitor shall be paid by the visitor in accordance with the scale of charges appearing on the resthouse notice board.

10. (1) Any complaint which a visitor may have to make about the resthouse or the resthouse-keeper shall be noted in the complaint book kept in the resthouse.

(2) It shall be the duty of the resthouse-keeper to produce the complaint book when called upon to do so by any visitor.

(3) No remark or complaint about the resthouse shall be written in the book in which the resthouse charges are entered.

- (a) where the number of persons attending does not exceed twenty-four, a fee (in lieu of occupation charges set out in the Schedule hereto) of Rs. 15 for the first six hours, and Rs. 2 for every additional hour or part thereof; and
- (b) where the number of persons attending ~x~eeds twenty four, occupation charges at the rates specified in the Schedule hereto.

12. A person in actual occupation of the resthouse shall have a prior claim to the use of any garage or stable atta hed to the resthouse, over persons not in occupation of the resthouse.

13. The owner or hirer of a private vehicle garaged in the resthouse or parked anywhere within the resthouse premises shall, notwithstanding that he himself has not occupied the resthouse, pay the appropriate occupation fee for the period during which the vehicle is so garaged or parked, in addition to the fee for parking the vehicle or for the use of the garage.

14. It shall be lawful for the Chairman to prohibit the use of the resthouse by any visitor who is convicted of a breach of any of these rules.

15. The resthouse keeper shall 'not permit any person or persons to occupy any part of the resthouse for any immoral purpose.

16. No visitor or servant of a visitor shall misbehave or conduct himself in such manner as to cause annoyance to other persons using the resthouse.

17. No visitor shall be permitted to bring a dog to the resthouse.

18. Officers of the Council who have been in the service of the Council for a period of not less than two years shall be charged, for the use of the resthouse or any part thereof, half the rates specified in the Schedule hereto. This concession shall also apply to the members of the family of every such officer.

19. Any public servant occupying the resthcuse while on duty in connection with any matter appertaining to the Council shall be charged occupation fees at half the rates specified in the Schedule hereto.

20. A breach of any of these rules shall be punishable with a fine not exceeding fifty rupees.

21. In these rules-

" Chairman " means the Chairman of the Council;

"Council" means the Vavuniya Urban Council; and

"Resthouse" means the Vavuniya Resthouse.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE

Examination for Recruitment to Grade IV of the Local Government Electrical Superintendents' Service-1967

A competitive examination for recruitment to Grade IV of the Local Government Electrical Superintendents' Service will be held shortly by the Local Government Service Commission in Colombo. The date of the examination will be notified later. The examination will be conducted in Sinhala and English.

2. Salary and Conditions of Service.—(a) Successful candidates will be appointed as and when vacancies occur to posts of Electrical Superintendents, Grade IV, in the Local Government Service, on the salary scale of Rs. 1,392 per annum rising by annual increments of Rs. 72 to Rs. 2,688 per annum with Efficiency Bar before Rs. 1,968 per annum. Rent Allowance, a temporary Cost of Living Allowance and a temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government rates and conditions. The posts are permanent and pensionable and the selected candidates will be eligible for Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension benefits.

(b) Successful candidates will be appointed on an acting basis in terms of Regulation 22 (2) of the Local Government Service Regulations and their confirmation in the posts will be considered at the end of the acting period. The acting period will be six months in the first instance. They will also be subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance (Cap. 264), any further amendments of the Local Government Service Ordinance and any regulations framed thereunder.

(c) The selected candidates may be required to furnish security either in cash or by fidelity guarantee bond through a Guarantee Association approved by the Commission.

(d) The selected candidates will be required to reside within the limits of the respective Local Authorities to which they are appointed.

3. Eligibility.—Grade I and Grade II Electrical Foremen in the Local Government Service who have been confirmed in their posts on or before 4.1.1967, will be eligible to take up this examination. They should forward their applications through the Heads of the Local Authorities in which they are serving.

4. (a) Applications.—Applications for admission to the examination must be made on the specimen form given below and must be addressed to the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, P. O. Box 530, Colombo.

(b) Applications must be sent by registered post to reach the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, on or before 4th January, 1967. Applications received after that date will be rejected.

(c) Candidates must forward their applications through the Heads of the Local Authorities in which they work. If any candidate fails to do so, he will be regarded as disqualified.

(d) Candidates are requested to forward their application to the Head of the Local Authority in which they work, well in time with a request that they may be transmitted to the Chair-man, Local Government Service Commission, on or before 4th January, 1967.

N.B.—(a) Applications not made in the prescribed form will be rejected.

(b) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this notification will be rejected.

5. Admission to the Examination.—(i) The Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, will issue admission forms to those candidates whose applications are accepted. Candidates presenting themselves for the examination must produce to the officer appointed to supervise the examination, their forms of admission. A candidate not producing such forms will be dis-ouslified qualified.

(ii) Candidates must sit for the examination at the examination hall assigned to them. A candidate presenting himself at an examination hall other than the one assigned to him will be refused admittance to the examination.

(iii) A copy of the time-table will be forwarded together with the Admission Form. Every candidate presenting himself for the examination, must give up his Admission Form to the Supervis-ing Examiner on the day of the examination.

(iv) If a candidate does not receive his Admission Form at least seven days before the day of the examination, he should communicate with the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, informing him that he has not received the Admis-sion Form and giving the following particulars:—

N.B.-Admission to the examination does not constitute acceptance of eligibility.

6. If a candidate is found to be ineligible according to the Regulations for this examination, his candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage, prior to, during or after the examination.

7. Should any of the particulars furnished by candidates be found to be false within their knowledge, they will, if appointed, be liable to be dismissed. The wilful suppression of any material fact will be similarly penalised.

8. Leave to Officers to attend Examination .-- Municipal Com-missioners/Special Commissioners and Chairmen of Local Authorities are kindly requested to grant duty leave to officers serving in their Councils, whose applications are accepted by the Chair-man, Local Government Service Commission, to present themselves at the examination.

9. Identity Cards.—Candidates will be required to prove their identity in the examination hall to the satisfaction of the Super-visor for each subject they offer. For this purpose any one of the following documents will be accepted:—

- (a) Identity Card issued by the Postmaster-General.
- (b) A valid passport issued within 3 years preceding the date of this examination.
- (c) Any certificate, licence or other documents embodying a photograph of the holder and issued within the 3 years preceding the date of this examination, on the authority of a Government Department.
- (d) A passport size photograph with the following attestation on the reverse made by a person eligible to provide such attestation on the signature form.

10. Scheme of Examination.—The Examination will be held in two parts, viz., Part I (written) and Part II (viva voce). The subjects of the Examination and marks assigned to each subject are given below. In written papers, marks will be deducted for bad handwriting and mistakes in spelling. Candidates whose writing is illegible are likely to be disqualified.

11. The written examination will be held first and on the results of it candidates will be selected for the Viva Voce Test, which too, will be held in Colombo. The number of candidates to be called for this test will be fixed by the Local Government Service Commission.

12. The names of selected candidates will be published in Part IV of the Government Gazette and they will be given appointments as and when vacancies occur.
