THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

MASOOR DHALL

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Rathgama Gamage Jayatissa, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Trincomalee, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. T/8/63 of September 2, 1963, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette (Extraordinary) No. 13,749 of September 4, 1963;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto, to be a wholesale dealers, maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross, above which Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—shall not be sold within the areas specified in column 1 of the first Schedule hereto;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer, above which Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—shall not be sold within the areas specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—for the purpose of resale or any sale in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be sale by wholesale,
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—hundred weight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be sale by retail;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or in that vehicle a quantity of Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—in a suitable container, with the maximum prices fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by the customers;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—by wholesale shall, and every person who sells Masoor Dhall—imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—

 - (b) the quantity of such article sold (by weight), (c) the price paid for the quantity sold, and

 - (d) the nature of transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (ix) direct that when Masoor Dhall-imported split (Grade I) and locally milled (Grade II)—is sold, the maximum prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule and column 2 of the Second Schedule, shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.

WHITE REFINED SUGAR

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Ratgama Guruge Jayatissa, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Trincomalee, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. T/1/63 of February 25, 1963, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette (Extraordinary) No. 13,538 of February 28, 1963;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto, to be the Wholesale Dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross of White Refined sugar above sales should not take place within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the First Schedule;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the Retail Dealer's maximum retail price per pound net of White Refined Sugar above sales should not take place within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Second Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of White Refined Sugar for the purpose of resale or any sale of any quantity of White
 - Refined Sugar in a quantity of one hundredweight or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,

 (b) any sale of any quantity of White Refined Sugar less than one hundredweight for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,

 (c) "White Refined Sugar" shall exclude all forms of jaggery;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell White Refined Sugar which adulterated with any other article or with sugar of any inferior grade or quality;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who has White Refined Sugar in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspiciously at that place, or on that vehicle a quantity of White Refined Sugar in a suitable container, with the maximum prices fixed by this Order for White Refined Sugar, displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the White Refined Sugar and the prices could be clearly seen by any customer: by any customer;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "Pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells White Refined Sugar by wholesale shall, and every person who sells White Refined Sugar by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—

 - (a) the date of sale,
 (b) the quantity of White Refined Sugar sold (by weight),
 (c) the price paid for the quantity of White Refined Sugar sold, and
 (d) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (ix) direct that when White Refined Sugar is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the prices of the wrapper or container, if any, in which White Refined Sugar is sold.

CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

EEEF

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Ratgama Guruge Jayatissa, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Trincomalee, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. T/1/64 of June 4, 1964, published in Ceylon Government Gazette (Extraordinary) No. 14,052 of June 6, 1964;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Columns 2. 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum price per pound above which Beef of the description and grade specified at the heads of those Columns shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of that Schedule;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) "Beef" shall mean the flesh of cattle and buffaloes, but shall exclude all forms of offals,
 - (b) when the carcase of any animal as prepared for sale at the slaughter house (i.e., excluding head, hide, entrails, offals, hooves and such parts as are customarily excluded) is sold, the sale shall be deemed to be by "dead weight";
- (iv) direct that when Beef is sold with bones, the weight of the bones sold herewith shall not exceed 25 per cent. of the total weight sold;
- (v) direct that every trader who has, at any premises within the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, in his possession, Beef of the description and grade specified in that Schedule shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of beef of that description and grade;
- (vi) direct that Beef shall be sold or exposed for sale only in stalls set aside for this purpose and no meat of any other description and grade shall be sold or exposed for sale in those stalls;
- (vii) direct that every trader who has, at any premises within the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule heroto, in his possession, Beef of the description and grade specified in that Schedule, shall exhibit on a conspicuous position at the stall where such beef is sold a notice to the effect that only beef of that description and grade is sold at that stall;
- (viii) direct that when Beef is sold together with offals in the course of one transaction, the beef shall be weighed and sold seperately from the offals;
- (ix) direct that every trader, when selling Beef shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the Beef shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the Beef he purchases;
- (x) direct that every trader who sells Beef of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the Beef, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,
 - (b) the quantity of Beef sold (by weight),
 - (c) the description of Beef sold, and
 - (d) the price paid for the quantity of Beef sold;
- (xi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell the article specified in the Schedule adulterated with any other meat or flesh;
- (xii) direct that when the article specified in the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in Columns 2, 3 and 4, of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold; and
- (xiii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "Pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Ratgama Guruge Jayatissa, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Trincomalec, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. 2/T/60 of January 26, 1960, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette (Extraordinary) No. 12,051 of February 1, 1960;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which Mutton of the description and grade specified at the heads of those Columns shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of that Schedule;

- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) "Mutton" shall mean the flesh of a sheep or goat, but shall exclude all forms of offal;
- (iv) direct that when Mutton is sold with bones the weight of the bones sold therewith shall not exceed twenty-five per centof the total weight sold;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any Mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle or any vessel shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle or vessel, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices of Mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule fixed by this Order for that area;
- (vi) direct that when Mutton is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction, the mutton shall be weighed and sold seperately from the offal;
- (vii) direct that every trader when selling Mutton shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the mutton shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the mutton he purchases;
- (viii) direct that every trader who sells Mutton of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the mutton, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) date of sale.
 - (b) the quantity of Mutton sold (by weight),
 - (c) the description of mutton sold, and
 - (d) the price paid for the quantity of Mutton sold;
- (ix) direct that in every where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell the articles specified in the Schedule which is adulterated with any other meat or flesh;
- (x) direct that when the articles specified in the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in Columns 2 and 3 shall include the prices of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (xi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.
