THE FOOD CONTROL ACT (CHAPTER 171)

Regulation

The Food Control Regulations, 1952, published in *Gazette* No. 10,416 of 20th June, 1952, as amended from time to time, are hereby further amended under Head E—“Regulation for Allocation and Rationing of Controlled Commodities.” in Part III thereof, by the substitution in regulation 4 (1) of that Part, for the word “sold”, of the words “sold or issued”.

THE FOOD CONTROL ACT (CHAPTER 171)

Change of Legal Ration

IT is hereby notified in terms of Regulation 5 of Part II of Head E and Regulation 4 (1) of Part III of Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1952, that with effect from 19th December, 1966, until further notice, the weekly ration of rice or paddy—

- (1) which may be sold or issued by way of sale or otherwise to any person of any class specified in column I of the Schedule hereto who is over one year of age and is resident on an estate as defined in the Food Control Regulations, 1952; or
- (2) which may be sold or issued to any person, of any class specified in column I of the Schedule hereto who is over one year of age and is resident in any area, whether Urban or non-Urban (other than an estate) in which rationing is in force, and who is the holder of a ration book for a person of that class,

shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column II or III respectively of that Schedule.

A ‘pound’ or ‘lb.’ shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.
