Price Order No. G. 7 of 1965.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS

Order

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Gardiya Punchihewage Buddhadasa de Silva, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for Galle District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. G. 5 dated November 13, 1965, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,558 of November 15, 1965;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the price for the time being fixed under the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price for Colombo Municipality, increased by amounts specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross above which the article specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule shall not be sold within the area or the administrative district specified in column 2 of that Schedule;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the price for the time being fixed under the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), as the retail dealer's maximum retail price for the Colombo Municipality, increased by the amounts specified in column 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the article specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule shall not be sold within the area or the administrative district specified in column 2 of that Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of that Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at such place or in such vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container with the maximum price for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such manner that the article and the maximum price thereof could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "Pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any articles specified in column 1 of that Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of such articles sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (ix) direct that when any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto is sold, the maximum price referred to in columns 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.

RICE AND WHEAT FLOUR

Food Price Order No. R/43/65.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, John Vincent Gnanapragasam, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Ratnapura, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke with immediate effect my Food Price Orders Nos. R/33/1963 dated 1st March, 1963, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 13,552 of 6th March, 1963, in respect of Rice and Food Price Order No. R. 35/10/63 dated 6th August, 1963, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 13,726 of 12th August, 1963, in respect of flour;
- (2) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (3) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per 1 pound nett above which rice shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (4) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (5) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article, or with rice of an inferior description or grade;

- (6) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per 148 lbs. nett above which wheat flour shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in column 1 in the same Schedule ;
- (7) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 5 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per 1 pound nett above which wheat flour shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in column 1 on the same Schedule ;
- (8) direct for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of wheat flour in a quantity of 148 lbs. nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour less than 148 lbs. nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
 - (c) "Wheat Flour" shall be deemed to include any mixture of wheat flour with maize flour ;
- (9) direct that no person shall sell wheat flour which is adulterated with any other article except maize flour ;
- (10) direct that no person shall sell any mixture of wheat flour and maize flour which contains more than 10 per cent. by weight of maize flour ;
- (11) direct that when rice and/or wheat flour is sold, the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice or wheat flour is sold ;
- (12) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has rice and/or wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of rice and/or wheat flour in a suitable container with the maximum prices for rice and/or wheat flour fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the rice and/or wheat flour and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any consumer ;
- (13) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight ;
- (14) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any rice and/or wheat flour by wholesale shall, and every person who sells rice and/or wheat flour by retail, on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of this sale ;
 - (b) the quantity of rice and/or wheat flour sold by (weight) ;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold ; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.

Note.—(i) These prices do not constitute fixed prices at which rice and flour must be sold. They are the MAXIMUM prices above which sales should not take place.

(ii) The Maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of rice which is less than 1 cwt. nett, and sold by wholesale should, as usual, be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per one cwt. nett specified above.

(iii) The Maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of wheat flour which is less than or more than 148 lbs. nett and sold by wholesale should, as usual, be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per 148 lbs. nett specified above.

(iv) The price for any area not mentioned above but situated within two specified areas mentioned shall be the price fixed for the specified area closest to such place.

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
