Proclamations by the Governor-General

To: NILA AENEAS DE SILVA WIJESKERA, Esquire.

GREETINGS:

WHEREAS it appears to me to be necessary to appoint a Commission of Inquiry for the purposes hereinafter mentioned:

NOW, therefore, I, WILLIAM GOPALLAWA, Governor-General, reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence, ability and fidelity, do, in pursuance of the provisions of section 2 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act (Chapter 393), by these presents appoint you, the said NILA AENEAS DE SILVA WIJESKERA, Esquire, to be my Commissioner for the purpose of inquiring into and reporting on the following matters:—

- (1) the causes that led to the strike by a section of the student body of the University of Ceylon, Peradeniya, on or about the Seventh of December, 1965;
- (2) the events and incidents that led to the summoning of Police assistance by the University authorities on 11th December, 1965;
- (3) whether the aforesaid strike was motivated, instigated or encouraged by any person, group of persons or any organisation outside the student body of the University of Ceylon, Peradeniya; and, if so, who were so responsible and for what purpose this was done;
- (4) whether there was any maladministration or neglect of duty on the part of the authorities responsible for the administration of the University of Ceylon, Peradeniya, that was partly or wholly responsible for the strike or its continuance;
- (5) what remedial measures should be taken to prevent the occurrence of such situations in the future; and
- (6) any other matter connected with or incidental to the matters specified above in respect of which you may receive representations;

and to make recommendations in respect of the matters investigated by you.

AND I do hereby authorize and appoint you, the said Commissioner, to hold all such inquiries and make all such investigations into the aforesaid and other like matters as may appear to you to be necessary, and require you to transmit to me, before the 17th day of January, 1966, a report thereon under your hand:

AND I do hereby direct that the inquiry shall, except where you may deem it necessary or advisable to take proceedings in camera, be held in public:

AND I do hereby require and direct all public officers and other persons to whom you may apply for assistance or information for the purposes of your inquiries and investigations to render all such assistance and furnish all such information as may be properly rendered and furnished in that behalf.

Miscellaneous Departmental Notices

NOTIFICATION REGARDING SCHEDULES A AND C OF THE LICENSING OF TRADERS (No. 1) REGULATIONS, 1961 MADE UNDER THE LICENSING OF TRADERS ACT, No. 62 OF 1961

BY a Notification appearing in the *Government Gazette* No. 14,578 of 4.12.65, the Regulations made by the Minister of Commerce and Trade under the Licensing of Traders Act, No. 62 of 1961, have been amended by the addition of new items to those already appearing under Schedule A and Schedule C of the Regulations. The legal obligations arising out of the inclusion of any article in these Schedules are set out in the Regulations framed under the Licensing of Traders Act. Although the Regulations apply to articles of food and drink and to miscellaneous articles this notification is concerned with miscellaneous articles only and the attention of traders is invited to the following requirements of the Regulations so far as they apply to articles other than food and drink :—

- (1) Every licensed trader who is a wholesale trader shall display in a conspicuous place in his place of business all such miscellaneous articles specified in Schedule A as are sold or offered for sale by him ; and he shall in addition transmit to the Licensing Authority, who is the Government Agent of the Administrative District, on or before the 7th day of each month, on a form that will be provided by him, the particulars of the stocks held by him as on the last day of the preceding month.
- (2) Every licensed trader who is an importer of any miscellaneous article specified in Schedule C shall on or before the 7th day of each month transmit to the Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) a return substantially on the form given below.
- (3) The miscellaneous articles set out in Schedule A and Schedule C are :—

- Matches,
- Bicycle tyres and tubes,
- Flashlight batteries,
- Transistor radio batteries,
- Exercise books (40 and 80 pages),
- Electric bulbs (15 watts to 150 watts),
- Incandescent mantles,
- Dry cell batteries (wireless),
- Cotton sewing thread (white),
- Mammoties.
- Building materials (Iron and steel)—
 - Bars,
 - Rods,
 - Angles shapes and sections,
 - Plates,
 - Sheets,
 - H. Iron,
 - Channel Iron,
 - Bolts and Nuts,
 - Pipes,
 - B. R. C. Fabric.
