*Pacific Ocean—Wachuset Shoal reported.*

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 550 of 1899) that information has been published in the *Shipping Gazette* of August 29, 1899, that Mr. Lambert, master of the ship *Wachuset*, reports that his vessel passed over a shoal with a depth of 5 or 6 fathoms on it, in approximately lat. 32° S., long. 151° W.

It has been placed on the Chart in this position and marked *Wachuset*, 1899.

*Eastern Archipelago—Borneo—Bruni Bay—Abana Rock marked by Buoy.*
