MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, October 13, 1899.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated October 7, 1899.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Allan Perry; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; Mr. H. T. S. Ward; the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; and Mr. H. A. Jayawardene.

The Minutes of September 8, 1899, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of September 8, 1899, be confirmed.

1 & 2. Pursuant to notice Mr. Chas. P. Dias presented a petition from certain residents in St. Sebastian and Hulftsdorp streets complaining of the latrine in the former place, and moved that a Committee be appointed to consider the same and report to the Council whether it is desirable to remove the latrine or not.

Mr. C. P. Dias, by leave of Council, amended his motion as follows:—That the petition be referred to the

Standing Committee.

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. H. A. Jayawardene and carried unanimously.

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. R. H. Morgan moved "that a Special Committee, consisting of the Chairman, Mr. F. H. Grinlinton, Mr. H. T. S. Ward, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, and the mover, be appointed to ascertain the cause of the water level of the Colombo lake being so low at present—three to form a quorum."

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried unanimously.

empowered to order the prohibition of work connected with plumbago in any place whenever upon representation by the neighbouring householders or otherwise the Chairman finds that in any particular case the work is so conducted as to become a nuisance or to create an inconvenience.'

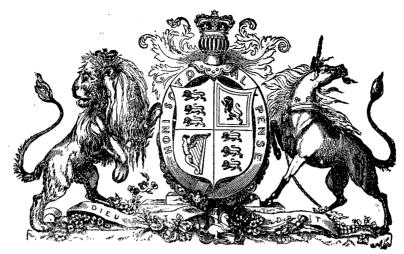

11. That no person other than the licensee shall sell or expose for sale any opium under his license, either as agent or servant of the licensee, unless the name of such agent or servant be first registered in the Municipal Office.

12. That daily accounts shall be kept in a form to be prescribed by the Chairman, Municipal Council, Galle, of the quantities of opium received, sold, and remaining on hand at the end of each day.

Wholesale licenses shall be issued only to retail dealers.
