#### GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

1. *Allowances.*—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

2. *Conditions of Service.*—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute at their option a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution in either case will be equal to 7 1/2 per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

4. *New Entrants to the Public Service.*—(i) The period of probation/trial of New-Entrant Officers appointed to pensionable posts/non-pensionable posts, as the case may be, shall be three years, unless a longer period is prescribed in respect of any posts.

(ii) All New-Entrant Officers must subscribe to the condition that they will conform to the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any laws and rules that now exist or may be introduced in the future for giving effect to the language policy of the Government.

(iii) (a) They should acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language—Sinhala—during their period of probation/trial, except in exceptional cases where it is not essential for the efficient discharge of their duties.

(b) Their confirmation, at the expiry of the period of probation/trial, will depend *INTER ALIA*, on their passing within specified periods of time prescribed proficiency tests in Sinhala, leading up to a level not higher than the J. S. C. standard. Failure to pass these proficiency tests within the prescribed periods will result in the non-payment of the increments falling due, until the tests are passed. The services of those officers who do not reach the requisite standard of proficiency in Sinhala by the end of their period of probation/trial will be liable to be terminated.

Note.—Those who qualify for entry into the Public Service through the Sinhala medium will be exempted from passing these proficiency tests in Sinhala as a pre-requisite for confirmation.

5. *Qualifications required.*—(i) Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

(ii) A candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate examination or equivalent or higher examination shall have a pass in the Sinhala Language or its equivalent obtained at the Senior School Certificate examination or its equivalent if he is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium. (This requirement will not apply to those officers who are in the Public Service from a date prior to January 1, 1961, and who seek appointment to other posts in the Public Service).

6. **War Service Concession.**—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord) will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

7. **Other requirements.**—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service who are qualified must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. Every such officer applying for a post advertised by the Secretary, Public Service Commission, must however, notify the date of despatch by him of his application, direct to the Secretary, Public

### Special Posts Grade I, in Maha Vidyalayas

APPLICATIONS are invited for Special Posts Grade I in Government Sinhala/Tamil and Muslim Maha Vidyalayas. Applications which should be on printed forms provided by this office, should reach the Secretary, Public Service Commission, P. O. Box 500, Colombo 1, on or before the following date:—

(a) Local Applications 28th March, 1969.

(b) Overseas Applications 3rd April, 1969.

*N. B.*—Those who have already applied for these posts in terms of the advertisement published by me in Part I, Section II of the Government Gazette No. 14,831 of December 6, 1968, and the amended Gazette Notification published in Government Gazette No. 14,838 of January 24, 1969, need not apply again.

(i) Overseas candidates may forward the form of application within the prescribed time, if they so desire, to the office of the Ceylon Representative abroad assigned to or nearest to the country of their residence for transmission to the Secretary, Public Service Commission.

(ii) **Medical Examination and Passage.**—Ceylonese officers selected abroad for appointment under the Ceylon Government will be required to present themselves for examination to approved Medical Practitioners with a view to it being ascertained whether they are physically fit for service. 4. **Qualifications.**—Every candidate must furnish satisfactory proof to establish the following:—

(i) Applicants should not be less than 30 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date 28.3.69 of the local applications. (The upper age limit will not apply to those who are already in Government Service).

(ii) A trained graduate or a person with equivalent qualifications who count at least 5 years service as a teacher.

(iii) An Hons. Graduate (1st or 2nd Class) of a recognised University who counts 5 years teaching experience after graduation or a person with equivalent qualifications who counts 5 years teaching experience after graduation.

(iv) A graduate of a recognised university with 7 years teaching experience after graduation or a person with equivalent qualifications who counts 7 years teaching experience after graduation.

(v) A graduate of a recognised University with at least 10 years teaching experience or a person with equivalent qualifications who counts 10 years teaching experience.

OR

(vi) A Grade II Special Post holder, who counts at least 5 years service as a Grade II Special Post holder.

*Note.*—1. Applicants should possess a good knowledge of Sinhala/Tamil. Those selected will be required to pass Sinhala/Tamil Language or Literature in the G. C. E. (Ordinary Level) Examination within 3 years from the date of appointment, unless they already possess equivalent or higher qualifications. The period taken in excess of 3 years to qualify in Sinhala/Tamil will operate as a deferment of increment.

Note.—2. No period of study leave or no-pay leave will be counted in calculating the period of service as a trained graduate/graduate/secondary trained teacher/Sinhala or Tamil trained teacher.

**Unicef Scholarships in Home Science**

PARAGRAPH 3 of the notification appearing in *Government Gazette* No. 14,839 of 31.1.69 is hereby amended as follows:

**3. Eligibility: Candidates should:—**

- (i) be citizens of Ceylon ;
- (ii) be not more than 30 years of age on 1.7.69;
- (iii) possess qualifications under one of the following categories—
  - (a) Ceylon G.C.E. (adv. level) Examination in four subjects at one sitting including Chemistry, provided they have obtained passes in Home Science, Needle-work, Mathematics or Arithmetic, English ('A' or 'B' syllabus) and Sinhala or Tamil ('A' or 'B' syllabus) at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination.

OR

- (b) Ceylon S.S.C. or G.C.E. (Ord. Level) Examination in six subjects at not more than two sittings including passes in Home Science, Needle-work, Mathematics or Arithmetic, English ('A' or 'B' syllabus) (Preference will be given to those having passes in Chemistry) ;

(iv) should be able to teach in Sinhala or Tamil.

2. Those who have already applied for those scholarships in terms of the *Gazette* notification of 31.1.69 need not apply again. The closing date for applications is extended to 28.3.1969.

**Post of Plumber—Class II**

APPLICATIONS are invited from candidates possessing the under-mentioned qualifications for the post of Plumber, Class II, in the office of the Ministry of Education and Cultural Affairs. - (ii) If the appointee is a new entrant to the Public Service for purposes of the Official Language Act—
  - (a) The period of trial will be 3 years;
  - (b) He should comply with any rules already made or that may hereafter be made for giving effect to the Language policy of the Government and in particular for implementing the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956.
- (iii) If the holder of a permanent post under Government is selected for appointment he should serve in acting capacity for a specified period.
- (iv) The appointee should serve in any part of the Island.
- (v) The appointment will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders and Regulations and any other Orders and Regulations that will be issued from time to time by the Government.
- (vi) The selection will be made through an interview and a practical test.

**3. Salary Scale.**—The salary scale attached to the post is as follows:—

- (a) For those serving in Colombo or in an institute recognised by the Treasury as an engineering and industrial workshop, at the rate of Rs. 2.30 per diem during the first six months, thereafter Rs. 750—42—1,296 per annum.
- (b) For those serving in an institute not recognised by the Treasury as an engineering and industrial workshop in outstations, at the rate of Rs. 2.10 per diem during the first six months, thereafter Rs. 750—42—1,086.

**4. Qualifications required—**

- (a) Every applicant should be an employee in the office of the Ministry of Education and Cultural Affairs or in a department under the Ministry;
- (b) should not be less than 21 years and not more than 35 years of age. The upper age limit will not apply to those already in Government service;
- (c) should be of excellent moral character and physically sound;
- (d) (i) should be able to read and write;
- (ii) should be able to read a scale of 1/32";
- (iii) should possess a knowledge of the names, use and maintenance of implements required for the trade;

- (iv) should possess a good knowledge of the duties that will be assigned to him;

- (v) should be able to read and understand simple drawings ;

- (e) should possess the undermentioned qualifications in addition to the qualifications stated at (a), (b), (c) and (d). These qualifications are stated in order of preference—

- (i) should possess at least 5 years' service in classes III and IV of the labour grades of which at least 3 years' service should be in class III ; or
- (ii) if the period of service in class II is less than 3 years' with prior service in class IV, should possess a total of 8 years' service in classes III and IV taking 2 years' service in class IV as being equivalent to one year's service in class III ; or
- (iii) should possess at least 2 years' service in class III with (a) at least 3 years' service as a class II tradesman or (b) 6 years' service as a class III tradesman of a recognised institute ; or
- (iv) should possess not less than 8 years' service in class IV ; or
- (v) should be a departmental employee in class III or IV, with not less than 5 years' prior service as a plumber in a recognised institute. (Employees of this category will be considered, if employees belonging to categories (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) above are not available. Further, the prior service should be substantiated by certificates).

*Note.*—Service as a tradesman in the United Kingdom bases will be accepted as service in a recognised institute.

5. Candidates will be required to produce any or all of the following documents when called upon to do so:—

- (a) highest educational certificate ;
- (b) certificate in support of vocational and/or technical qualifications;
- (c) certificates in support of prior service in recognised institutes referred to in sub para. (e) of para. 4;
