#### Rules

The Rules made under the Council of Legal Education Incorporation Ordinance, as last amended by notification dated April 22, 1968, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 14,802 of May 17, 1968, were further amended at a meeting of the

Council of Legal Education held on December 9, 1968, as follows:—

(a) Rule 23 (1) by the addition, at the end of proviso (d), of the following:—

“(A pass in English Literature with either a pass in ‘A’ syllabus of English Language or a credit pass in ‘B’ syllabus of English Language, at a General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination held after 1964, will be deemed as satisfying the requirement of a credit pass in ‘A’ syllabus of English Language.”)

(b) Rule 23 (2) by the addition, at the end of proviso (b), of the following:—

“(A pass in English Literature with either a pass in ‘A’ syllabus of English Language or a credit pass in ‘B’ syllabus of English Language, at a General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination held after 1964, will be deemed as satisfying the requirement of a credit pass in ‘A’ syllabus of English Language.”)

(c) Rule 23 (5) by the addition of the word “Ethics” after the word “Geology” in line 12 of “N.B.—The subjects approved by the Council for the purposes of Rule 23”.
