It is further ordered that the last will and testament made by the deceased above named on 28th December, 1968, the original of which has been produced and is now deposited in this court marked " X " be and the same is hereby declared proved and that the petitioner above named is the executor named therein and that he is hereby declared entitled to have probate thereof issued to him accordingly on his paying estate duty and taking oath of office unless the respondents above named or any person or persons whomsoever lawfully interested therein shall, on or before the 27th day of May, 1969, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
