## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Masters Attendant Ordinance," No. 6 of 1865.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinance No. 6 of 1865 so as to limit the liability of pilots appointed by the Government of Ceylon: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Appointing of pilots by Governor.

- 1 (1) The Governor shall continue from time to time to appoint fit, proper, and qualified persons to be pilots for the purpose of conducting ships to or out of any port in the island.
- (2) The Governor may from time to time remove any pilot so appointed and appoint another in his stead.

Pilot's liability limited 2 A pilot appointed by the Governor shall not be liable for neglect or want of skill beyond the sum of one thousand rupees, and in the event of his being entitled to fees on account of pilotage in respect of the voyage in which he was engaged when he became so liable, his liability shall not exceed the said sum and the amount payable to him as such fees.

Non-liability of Government, owner, or master where pilot is employed.

3 The Government of Ceylon or the owner or master of a ship shall not be answerable to any person whatever for any loss or damage occasioned by the fault or incapacity of any pilot appointed by the Governor acting in charge of that ship within the limits of the ports of Colombo and Galle as defined in the schedule hereto.
