COMMITTEE OF INQUIRY ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT

THE Honourable Minister of Local Government has been pleased to appoint a Committee consisting of the following :—

Mr. V. C. Jayasuriya (Chairman)

Mr. D. S. de Silva

Dr. C. F. Amarasinghe

to examine and report with recommendations on :

- (i) The adequacy of the present sources of revenue of Local Authorities, the existing financial relations between Government and Local Authorities, and what new sources of revenue should be made available to Local Authorities to enable them to perform their functions more efficiently.
- (ii) Whether any changes should be made in the present method of election of Mayors/Chairmen of Local Authorities and in the powers and functions of the Mayors/Chairmen and in their relationship with the Councils, for the more efficient functioning of Local Authorities.
- (iii) Any other matters that may be referred to the Committee.

The Committee invites representations on the matters under inquiry from Local Authorities, Associations of Local Authorities, Local Government employees, Rate Payers Associations and other interested persons and organisations. The representations should preferably be in quadruplicate and sent to the undersigned within two weeks from the date of publication of this notice. Where necessary the Committee would provide an opportunity for discussion on any matters arising from the representations, at a date and time to be notified in due course. The office of the Committee would be situated at No. 8, Bambalapitiya Drive, Colombo 4 (Rent Control Board of Review Office).
