FUGITIVE PERSONS ACT, No. 29 OF 1969 Order under Section 1

THE AWARD

This is an award made under section 17 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments (Revised Edition, 1956), as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, Nos. 14 of 1957, 62 of 1957 and 4 of 1962. It relates to a dispute between The Ceylon Universities Clerical and Technical Assistants' Association, University of Ceylon, Peradeniya (hereinafter referred to as the "applicant"), and University of Ceylon, Peradeniya (hereinafter referred to as the "respondent").

The Honourable the Minister of Labour by his order dated 12th December, 1967, made under section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, referred this matter to me for arbitration. The Commissioner of Labour, by his statement of 7th December, 1967, has stated that the matter in dispute is whether the termination of employment of the applicant is justified and to what relief he is entitled.

When this dispute was taken up for inquiry on 19.12.69, Mr. Navaratnam, Proctor, appeared for the respondent. Mr. R. L. de S. Karunanayake represented the applicant.

It was submitted by the parties that the workman in respect of whom this application has been made was now dead. It was agreed between the parties that in view of this situation that no award be made with regard to this dispute. It was submitted by the representative of the Union that it be placed on record that they would wish to pursue this matter with the Vice Chancellor and the Chancellor and hope that this matter would receive their sympathetic consideration.

Mr. Navaratnam on behalf of the respondent also submitted that if the applicant were to make an appeal to the respondent it would receive due consideration.

I therefore make no award.
