THE FINANCE ACT, No. 11 OF 1963**National Lotteries Rules**

THE Rules made under the National Lotteries Board under section 11 (a) and 20 of the Finance Act, No. 11 of 1963, and published in *Gazette* No. 14,853 of May 9, 1969, and amended subsequently are hereby repealed and the following new Rules are substituted therefor, with effect from January 1, 1970.

RULES

- These Rules may be cited as the National Lotteries Board (No. 2) Rules, 1967.
- The National Lotteries shall be divided into 2 classes as follows:—
 - The National Lottery in respect of which tickets shall be sold at the price of 50 cents each, and
 - The National Lottery, termed "Jathika Samapatha" in respect of which tickets shall be sold at the price of Re. 1 each.
- In respect of the National Lottery specified under Rule 2 (1)—
 - there shall be not less than twelve and not more than fifty-two national lotteries conducted in each year;
 - every ticket in such national lottery shall be sold at the price of fifty cents and such price shall be stated on the face of every such tickets;
 - every ticket in such national lottery shall bear on its face a statement that such lottery is a national lottery conducted by the Board under the Act;
 - every ticket in such national lottery shall state on the face of it, the date on which such lottery is to be drawn; and

(v) prices shall be awarded in such national lottery in accordance with the following provisions:—

- (a) Subject to the succeeding provisions of this rule, forty per centum of the gross proceeds of such lottery shall be appropriated for the distribution of prizes.
- (b) Twenty per centum of the gross proceeds of such lottery or Rs. 100,000, whichever sum is less, shall be awarded as the First Prize.
- (c) Eight per centum of such proceeds or Rs. 40,000 whichever sum is less, shall be awarded as the Second Prize.
- (d) Two per centum of such proceeds or Rs. 10,000, whichever sum is less, shall be awarded as the Third Prize.
- (e) Hundred other prizes of equal value, each of which shall not exceed Rs. 5,000, shall be awarded from the balance of the forty per centum of such proceeds allocated for prizes.

4. In respect of the National Lottery termed "Jathika Sampatha"—specified under rule 2 (2)—

- (i) there shall be not more than twelve such "Jathika Sampatha" conducted each year;
- (ii) every ticket in such Jathika Sampatha shall be sold at the price of Re. 1 each;
- (iii) every such ticket shall state on the face of it the date on which such lottery is to be drawn;
- (iv) tickets shall be issued to such agents as are determined by the Board, and each such ticket shall state on its body the price, the details of prizes to be awarded and relevant information, as determined by the Board; and

(v) prizes shall be awarded in such "Jathika Sampatha" in accordance with the following provisions:—

- (a) Subject to succeeding provisions of this rule, forty per centum of the gross proceeds of such lottery shall be appropriated for the distribution of prizes.
- (b) A prize of Rs. 100,000 or 10 per centum of the gross proceeds whichever is less, shall be awarded as First Prize;
- (c) A prize of Rs. 100,000 or 10 per centum of the gross proceeds whichever is less shall be awarded as a Second Prize.
- (d) A prize of Rs. 100,000 or 10 per centum of the gross proceeds whichever is less shall be awarded as a Third Prize, and
- (e) Two hundred other prizes of equal value shall be awarded from the balance of the 40 per centum gross proceeds allocated for prizes.

5. The drawing of lots in public for the purpose of determining the prize winners in a National Lottery shall take place on the date specified in the tickets in such lottery and at such time and place as may be determined by the Board and published in a Sinhalese daily newspaper, a Tamil daily newspaper and an English daily newspaper. Such date, time and place may be changed by the Board for whatsoever reason deemed necessary by due notification. Such lots shall be drawn—

- (1) from a drum or drums or in any other manner determined by the Board from time to time;
- (2) in the presence of not less than two Members of the Board and a Police Officer not below the rank of Assistant Superintendent; and
- (3) by persons other than members or officers or servants of the Board.

6. No ticket which is declared a prize winning ticket in any national lottery shall be eligible for any further prizes in the same lottery.

7. The Board may employ agents for the sale of tickets in a national lottery on such terms and conditions as it may deem fit and the remuneration payable to any such agents shall be such percentage of the total value of the tickets sold by such agent as may be determined by the Board.

8. A notice stating the number of each winning ticket in a national lottery and if known, the name and address of the winner thereof shall be published by the Board in a Sinhala daily newspaper, a Tamil daily newspaper and an English daily newspaper circulating in Ceylon and copies of such notice shall be sent by the Board to the Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Finance and to the Inspector-General of Police.

9. The Head Office of the Board shall be situated in Colombo. The Board may establish such number of branch offices in other parts of Ceylon as it may deem necessary.

10. The Board shall cause the following books of account to be kept—

- (1) a register of cheques and other remittances received by the Board;
- (2) a general cash book;
- (3) a book containing cash transactions relating to each national lottery;
- (4) a petty cash book;
- (5) a register of the stock of tickets;
- (6) a register of the tickets sold;
- (7) a book containing a summary relating to the distribution of the national lottery prizes;
- (8) a book containing a statement relating to the non-effective tickets;
- (9) a journal;
- (10) a votes ledger and a general ledger;
- (11) a salary register; and
- (12) such other books and statements as the Board may deem necessary from time to time.

11. The Board may open one or more accounts in a bank or banks in which monies belonging to the Fund shall be deposited to the credit of that Fund.

12. Where any sum of money is received on behalf of the Board, the Board shall forthwith issue or cause to be issued an official receipt for the same. Receipt of such sum of money shall be duly entered in the appropriate books of account and such sum of money shall be deposited in the bank to the credit of the Fund.

13. (1) Every payment made out of the Fund shall be supported by a voucher prepared with accuracy and completeness, and every such payment shall be recorded in the appropriate books of account.

(2) Every voucher in respect of any payment for stores or printed tickets purchased on behalf of the Board shall be supported by a certificate issued by the store-keeper or his assistant or the officer assigned for the purpose to the effect that the stores or tickets so purchased have been received by him and that the particulars relating to such stores or tickets have been duly entered in the appropriate stock book or inventory.

14. The Board shall cause all books of account, receipts and vouchers to be made available to the Auditors for inspection.

15. At the end of each Financial Year, the Board shall—

- (a) cause to be prepared an income and expenditure account in respect of the Board's financial transactions during that year, and a balance sheet in respect of the assets and liabilities of the Board as at the end of that year; and
- (b) cause such income and expenditure account and balance sheet to be transmitted to the Auditor-General.

16. In these rules—

"Act" means the Finance Act, No. 11 of 1963;

"Board" means the National Lotteries Board established under the Act;

"gross proceeds" in relation to any national lottery means the aggregate of the face value of all tickets sold in such lottery;

"national lottery" means a lottery conducted by the Board for the purpose of the Act and include the "Jathika Sampatha";

"Financial year" has the same meaning as in the Act; and

"Fund" means the Fund of the Board.

The Honourable the Minister of Labour and Employment, by Order dated 28th September, 1969, by virtue of the powers vested in him by Section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon (1956 Revised Edition) as amended by Acts Nos. 14 and 62 of 1957, 4 of 1962 and 39 of 1968 (read with the Industrial Disputes (Special Provisions) Act, No. 37 of 1968) referred the above dispute to me for settlement by arbitration.

The Commissioner of Labour, by his statement dated 20th September, 1969, which accompanied the Hon. Minister's Order, set out the matter in dispute as follows:—

It appears that the respondent Company terminated the services of these four employees on the 31st August, 1969, on payment of one month's salary in lieu of notice on the basis of retirement due by reason of having exceeded the age of 55 years being the retiring age prescribed by the Company. The Union took up the position that 55 years was not in fact, the retiring age of the Company, which should correctly be 60 years; that the short notice given to the workers after such long service was unacceptable and indicated mala fides on the part of the Company which the Union interpreted as victimisation. The Company denied this. It was agreed by both parties that the ages and service of these workers were—

and that George Gunasekera was not a member of the Union.

On 6.11.69 this matter came up before me and the various aspects of the dispute were freely discussed and since there appeared to be some prospect of a settlement, inquiry was put out for 27.11.69.

On the latter date Parties informed Court that they had come to a settlement and filed a Memorandum to that effect, signed by Mr. S. R. de Silva, Asst. Secretary, Employers' Federation of Ceylon, on behalf of the Employer Firm and Mr. W. K. Wijemanne, President of the National Workers' Congress signed on behalf of the Union. Having perused the terms of that settlement and discussed them with the parties, I am satisfied that they are fair and reasonable and represent a just and equitable resolution of the dispute. I therefore make Award accordingly. A copy of the said Memorandum of Settlement is attached hereto. The Union and the Company also made mutual arrangement for the payment of the monies involved and for receipts to be filed in this Court.

4 (a) It is agreed that the employees named in the reference of the matter in dispute shall be made a payment on account of superannuation of a sum equivalent to half month's gross salary for each year of service for the period prior to 1st March 1948, the gross salary for this purpose being the salary drawn by the employees in June 1959, less any amount already accepted by the employees as a superannuation payment on retirement.
