ORDER

1. The power to make acting appointments in the case of District Judges, Commissioners of Requests and Magistrates is hereby delegated to the Secretary, subject to the following limitations:—

- The Secretary shall not make an acting appointment for a period of more than seven days at a time or for more than seven days in the aggregate in any one month.

(3) In the event of any default on the part of any of the allottees and tenant cultivators and where there are no allottees or tenant cultivators of any lands, proprietors of these lands, in contributing any uncommutable labour due under this scheme, the Government Agent may cause such labour to be performed by any other person and recover the cost thereof in the manner prescribed in Part VII of the Ordinance.
