ORDER made by the Minister of Local Government by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 5 (2) of the Village Councils Ordinance (Chapter 257).

Provision in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto is rrovision in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby made for the matters necessary to give effect to the division of the Sinhala Pattu village area in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Sinhala Pattu in the Polonnarual District, North Central Province, into the new village areas of Minneriya, Giritale and Medirigiriya, referred to in the Order published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 14,835/7 of January 9, 1969.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The Village Council of each new village area shall be the successor of the Village Council of the old village area for all purposes of the Village Council's Ordinance as may relate to that new village areas.
- 2. All the by-laws made by the Village Council of the old village area and in force on June 30, 1969, shall from July 1, 1969, continue in force in each village areas and shall be deemed to have been made by the Village Councils of that new village area.
- 3. The amount lying to the credit of the Communal Fund of the old village area on June 30, 1969, shall on July 1, 1969, be apportioned and credited to the Communal Fund of the new village areas of Minneriya, Giritale and Medirigiriya on the ratio of 7:3:6.
- 4. Each land, building or other immovable property vested in or under the control of the Village Council of the old village area on June 30, 1969, shall on July 1, 1969, deemed to be

vested in the Village Councils of the new village areas within which such land, building or other immovable property is situated.

- 5. All rights, debts, liabilities and obligations of the Village Council of the old village area shall in so far as they relate to each new village area be deemed to be transferred to the Village Councils of that new village areas as from July 1, 1969:
- Provided that the debt of Rs. 7,077.14 due from the former Clerk Mr. P. B. Herath to the village council of the old village area shall be deemed to be transferred to the Village Council of the new village area of Minneriya as from July 1, 1969.
- 6. (i) The legal proceedings pending in the District Court of Kurunegala in Case No. 2929/M. of the said court instituted by the Sinhala Pattu Village Council is assigned to the Village Council of the Minneriya village area and may be continued by the Minneriya Village Council as the successor to the said Village Council of the said Sinhala Pattu village area.
- (ii) The decree or order made by the District Court of Polonnaruws in favour of the Village Council of the Sinhals Pattu village area in the District Court Kurunegala by the Case No. 621 shall be deemed to have been made in favour of Minneriya Village Council.
- 7. The liabilities of the old Village Council in respect of contri-7. The liabilities of the old Village Council in respect of contributions towards the payment of pensions to its employees who have served in that Council, shall be divided in the ratio of 7:3:6 among the Village Councils of the new village areas of Minneriya, Giritale and Medirigiriya.
- 8. All the files of papers and documents maintained at the office of the Village Council of the old village area shall in so far as they relate to each new village area be deemed to be transferred to the Village Council of that new village areas as from July 1, 1969.
 - 9. In this Schedule-
- "new village area" unless otherwise specified means the village areas of Minneriya, Giritale and Medirigiriya as defined by the Orders published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 14,835/7 of January 9, 1969; and
- "old village area" means the village area of Sinhalapattu prior to the coming into being of the new village areas. 4-752-Gazette No. 14,903 of 24.4.70
