With reference to this Office Notice to Mariners No. 9 of 1900, information has been received from the Port Officer, Mangalore, that the fixed white light referred to therein was exhibited on the night of May 1, 1900, from a (cement) gray tower on the southern end of the enclosure known as the Marine yard at Mangalore. Latitude 12° 52' N., longitude 74° 50' E. approximately.
