REPORT OF THE AUDITOR-GENERAL ON THE ACCOUNTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE PROVIDENT FUND FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 1966

(Figures in this report have been rounded off to the nearset rupee)

The Accounts of the Public Service Provident Fund for the year ended September 30, 1966 were audited under my direction in pursuance of Section 24 (1) of the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance (Cap. 434).

The undermentioned financial statements for the year ended September 30, 1966 were rendered for audit by the Secretarys, Public Service Provident Fund on November 22, 1969:-

(i) Receipts and Payments for the year ended September 30, 1966;
(ii) Income Appropriation Account for the year ended September 30, 1966;
(iii) Balance Sheet as at September 30, 1966.

The observations arising from the audit of the accounts are given below :-

- 1. Outcome of Accounts.—According to the Income Appropriation Account a sum of Rs. 2,563,215 was available for distribution as interest for the year 1965-66 to the contributors at the rate of 4½% as compared with 3½% for the previous year.
- 2. Statement of Receipts and Payments—Bonus 1965-66—Rs. 4,116,061.—Section 7 (i) of the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance requires the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury to credit to the General Account of the Fund at the close of each financial year a sum equivalent to one and a half times the aggregate of the compulsory contributions made by the contributors during the financial year, for the payment of bonus. Accordingly a sum of Rs. 4,116,061 had been credited to the Fund by the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury on 30.9.66, although the correct amount that should have been credited was Rs. 3,332,849.

The excess sum of Rs. 783,213 credited by the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury had been transferred to the Consolidated Fund in August, 1969.

3. Awards to Contributors—Rs. 2,583,363.—Out of the total payment of Rs. 2,583,363 made to contributors during the year under review, 475 vouchers for amounts totalling Rs. 125,350 were not made available for audit as at the date of this report.

4. Recovery Registers.—(i) Regulation 9 (x) framed under the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance requires that departments and accounting units should forward duly reconciled registers of recoveries to the Public Service Provident Office by October 31, of the following year. Thirty seven registers in respect of the period 1961-62 to 1965-66 had not been received by the Fund Office as at February 28, 1970, particulars of which are given below:—

- (ii) In the absence of recovery registers the payments of awards to contributors were made on certified statements of recoveries furnished by heads of departments and accounting units.
- (iii) In terms of Regulation 8 (v) framed under the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance, amounts shown in the registers of recoveries of each department or accounting unit are required to be reconciled at the end of the year with the actual credit made to the Public Service Provident Fund in respect of that particular department or accounting unit. This requirement had not been complied with in regard to the recovery registers referred to above.
- It was mentioned in the reports relating to the years 1963-64 and 1964-65 that although staff was provided for the purpose of reconciling the individual balances in the loose leaf ledgers with the amounts in the recovery registers, the reconciliation had not been done. The position remained the same up to the date of this report.
