NOTICE is hereby given that a meeting will be held at 12 noon on January 31, 1898, at the Batticaloa Kachcheri, to elect three Unofficial Members of the Local Board of Health and Improvement, Batticaloa, for the years 1898 and 1899, under the provisions of Ordinances Nos. 7 of 1876 and 27 of 1890.

OTICE is hereby given to persons residing within the limits of the Local Board, Negombo, that the Board, acting under the provisions of section 3 of Ordinance No. 9 of 1887, has imposed an annual tax, payable in six days' labour, upon all persons residing within the limits of the Local Board who would have been liable, under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, to the performance of labour for the maintenance of the roads or other public means of communication by land or by water, if the Ordinance No. 7 of 1876 had not been passed. Such labour may be commuted by a money payment of Rs. 2 in the town of Negombo and the islands of Pitipana and Munnakkara, and Re. 1.50 in the island

of Duwa, on or before the 28th day of February, 1898, after that date the payment will be Rs. 4 and Rs. 3 respectively per head.

#### MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

THE Municipal Council, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 14 of Ordinance No. 26 of 1890, hereby have set apart the following public places for the purpose of bathing and for washing animals and clothes, and the Chairman of the Council hereby prohibits bathing or washing animals and clothes in any public places not set forth in this potice. place not set forth in this notice:

Public Bathing-places for Men, Women, and Children.

Kepu-ela.--Upper side of Hume road bridge.

Do. Near Nakanda bridge, Kandewatta road. Moragoda-ela.—At Hirimbure road bridge.

Ď٥. At Hirimbure cross road bridge.

Do. At Attoya bridge. Do. At railway bridge.

Do. Near Gangarama pansala.

Do. At Kachchiwatta bridge. Mahamodara lake.—Upper side of bridge.

Public Places for Washing Animals.

Kepu-ela.—Below Pattiya bridge, near railway station.

Mahamodara lake.—Lower side of bridge.

Moragoda-ela.—At the lower side of Kachchiwatta bridge.

Public Places for washing Clothes.

Kepu-ela.—Between bathing-place near anicut, Kandewatta road, and railway bridge, Colombo line. Moragoda-ela.—Between Milidowo bridge and the edanda over Moragoda-ela at Kanampitiya. Municipal well, Kaluwella.—Below the Roman Catholic church grounds.

Any person who bathes, washes animals or clothes contrary to the aforesaid prohibition shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding Rs. 50.
