GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

1. *Allowances.*—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

2. *Conditions of Service.*—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute at their option a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution in either case will be equal to 7 1/2 per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the island.

4. *New Entrants to the Public Service.*—(i) The period of probation/trial of New-Entrant Officers appointed to pensionable posts/non-pensionable posts, as the case may be, shall be three years, unless a longer period is prescribed in respect of any posts.

(ii) All New-Entrant Officers must subscribe to the condition that they will conform to the provision of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any laws and rules that now exist or may be introduced in the future for giving effect to the language policy of the Government.

(iii) (a) They should acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language—Sinhala—during their period of probation/trial, except in exceptional cases where it is not essential for the efficient discharge of their duties.

(b) Their confirmation, at the expiry of the period of probation/trial, will depend, *INTER ALIA*, on their passing within specified periods of time prescribed proficiency tests in Sinhala, leading up to a level not higher than the J. S. C. standard. Failure to pass these proficiency tests within the prescribed periods will result in the non-payment of the increments falling due, until the tests are passed. The services of those officers who do not reach the requisite standard of proficiency in Sinhala by the end of their period of probation/trial will be liable to be terminated.

Note.—Those who qualify for entry into the Public Service through the Sinhala medium will be exempted from passing these proficiency tests in Sinhala as a pre-requisite for confirmation.

5. *Qualifications required.*—(i) Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by regulation.

(ii) A candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate examination or equivalent or higher examination shall have a pass in the Sinhala Language or its equivalent obtained at the Senior School Certificate examination or its equivalent if he is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium. (This requirement will not apply to those officers who are in the Public Service from a date prior to January 1, 1961, and who seek appointment to other posts in the Public Service).

6. **War Service Concession.**—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord) will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

(b) (i) a Sangeetha Visarada degree or a diploma in North Indian Music of recognized institutions of Music in India;

OR

(ii) the Six-year Certificate in North Indian Music of the Government College of Fine Arts/Government College of Music;

(iii) the Final Certificate in Music of the Lanka Gandharva Sabha/Government Music Examination.

AND

(c) possesses outstanding ability in the use of at least one of the following instruments and ability in the use of one or more of the other instruments:—

Sitar, Sarod, Flute, Shenai, Violin, Esraj, Sarangi, Veena, Jalatharange, Valatharanga, Thalla, Pakwaj, Koll, Eholak.

AND

(d) possesses at least 3 years experience in teaching instrumental music and ability to teach and maintain records in Sinhala.

Note.—1. Preference will be given to those who have the ability to play several of the instruments mentioned above in addition to the instrument for which the applicant possesses outstanding ability.

2. Applicants who are already in Government service will also be considered irrespective of the qualifications referred to under 4 (a) (i), (ii) or (iii) if they possess the Junior School Certificate with other qualifications mentioned above.

(e) is of excellent moral character and physically sound.

5. **Terms of engagement.**—(i) The post is permanent and pensionable. Male appointees should contribute towards the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund.

(ii) The appointment will normally be subject to a period of three years probation. An officer already in the permanent and pensionable establishment in the Public Service, if selected, will be appointed on an acting basis for a period of one year.

ROYAL CEYLON NAVY

Enlistment of Sailors in Non-Artificer Branches

VACANCIES exist in the Regular Naval Force of the Royal Ceylon Navy for sailors to be enlisted in the Non-Artificer Branches as Seamen/Mechanics, Communicators, Writers, Stores Assistants and Sick Berth Attendants.

2. Applications are invited from candidates who possess the qualifications and satisfy the conditions given below.

3. *General Conditions.*—A Candidate must—

- (a) be a citizen of Ceylon ;
- (b) have passed the seventh standard in the Sinhalese, Tamil or English medium;
- (c) be of good character ;
- (d) possess the following minimum physical requirements :—
(i) Height 5 feet 4 inches
(ii) Weight 105 pounds
(iii) Chest Measurement .. 32 inches

- (e) *Age limit.*—be not less than 18 years of age and should not be more than 20 years of age as at 1st January, 1971.
- (f) Medical standards as prescribed by the Captain of the Navy.

Note.—Preference will be given to applicants (for enlistment in the other Non-Artificer Branches) who have passed the G.C.E. (Ordinary level) examination in a minimum of 4 subjects in one sitting, including Sinhalese or Tamil and Arithmetic or Mathematics

4. *Mode of Recruitment.*—Successful candidates will be enlisted on a common entry basis and will be selected for the different branches in the Navy after a period of initial training. Those who are found unsuitable for any reason will be discharged from the Regular Naval Force.

5. *Conditions of Service.*—Conditions of service will be governed by the Seamen's Enlistment and Service Regulations, 1950, (published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 10,187 of December 9, 1950) which are in force on the date of enlistment and the aforesaid regulations as amended from time to time thereafter.

6. *Period of Engagement.*—Successful candidates will be enlisted in the Regular Naval Force of the Royal Ceylon Navy in accordance with the provisions of the Seamen's Enlistment and Service Regulations, 1950, which are in force on the date of enlistment, and shall be subject to the aforesaid regulations as may be amended from time to time thereafter. The period of original enlistment of a Seaman in the Regular Naval Force, in accordance with the Seamen's Enlistment and Service Regulations, 1950, which are now in force is 12 years. It is proposed to amend the above quoted regulations to provide for the period of original enlistment of a Seaman enlisted in the Non-Artificer Branches to be 5 years and, before the expiry of the period of 5 years referred to above, such Seaman may, if his retention in the Regular Naval Force is considered necessary by the Captain of the Navy, be allowed to extend his service for a period not exceeding 7 years. It is also proposed to amend the above quoted regulations so that a seaman enlisted in any of the Non-Artificer Branches may, before the expiry of the period of 7 years referred to above, be allowed to re-engage for one or more periods not exceeding 20 years in all, if his retention in the Regular Naval Force is considered necessary by the Captain of the Navy.

7. *Rates of Pay and Allowances.*—Rate of pay and allowances for seamen of the Non-Artificer branches of the Regular Naval Force are as indicated in the Armed Services Pay Committee, Report, April, 1970, extracts of which are as follows :—

(a) *Rates of Pay.*—The pay of a sailor shall be at such of the following rates per annum as may be appropriate to him :—

Note.—“Specialist Rating” means a rating who has such qualifications as may be determined by the Captain of the Navy, with the concurrence of the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Defence and External Affairs.

(b) *Laundry Allowance.*—

- (i) a sailor accommodated in a mess shall be entitled to have his Naval clothing laundered free of charge at Navy expense ;
- (ii) a sailor living cut shall be entitled to such allowance as may be prescribed by the Captain of the Navy for the laundering of his Naval Clothing.

(c) *Good Conduct Pay.*—Good Conduct Pay shall be payable to every sailor in possession of Good Conduct Badges at such one of the following rates as may be appropriate to him :—

	<i>Rate per day Rs. c.</i>
(i) for one badge—on completion of 4 years qualifying service 0 25
(ii) for two badges—on completion of 8 years qualifying service 0 50
(iii) for three badges—on completion of 12 years qualifying service 0 75

8. The following rules govern applications for enlistment :—

- (a) Applications must be made in the Applicant's own handwriting as per specimen application form appearing at the end of this notice. Typewritten applications will not be accepted.
- (b) Applications are to be addressed to the Captain of the Navy, Navy Headquarters, P.O. Box 593, Colombo 1. Envelopes should be marked “RECRUITMENT—SAILORS” on the top left-hand corner, and should reach Naval Headquarters before 12 noon on 1st November, 1970.
- (c) Applications from Government employees should be forwarded through the Head of the Department concerned, together with a letter from the Head of the Department stating that the applicant will be released if selected.

Commonwealth Scholarships in Hong Kong—1971

APPLICATIONS are invited for the award of scholarships offered under the Commonwealth Scholarship and Fellowship Plan and tenable at the University of Hong Kong from the beginning of the academic year 1971 for following a course in Architecture (R.I.B.A.), Part II.

The scholarships are meant for persons of good intellectual promise who may be expected to make a significant contribution to the life of the country on their return after completion of the scholarship.

Note 1.—No application from a Government servant will be entertained unless the Head of his/her Department certifies in terms of Treasury Circular No. 514 of 16.5.60 that the training provided by the scholarship is essential in connection with a project and the particulars of such project are indicated as required in that circular.

Note 2.—Applications from employees of Boards, Corporations, Universities and similar Government-aided or sponsored Institutions should be sent through the heads of respective institutions, who should be requested to complete the certificate in cage 27 of the application appropriately, when forwarding the application.
