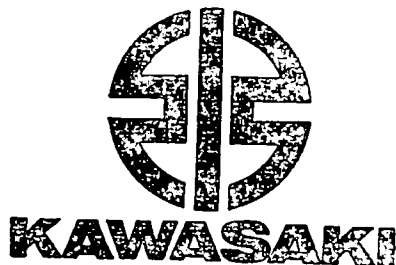

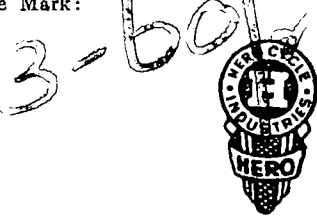

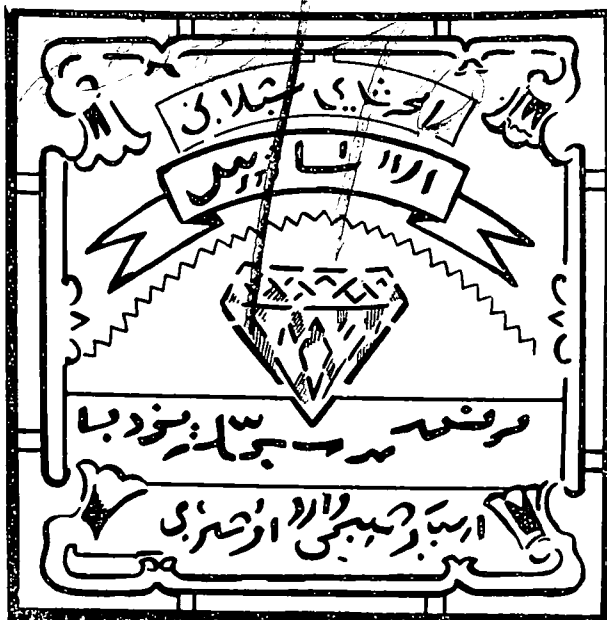

“ Improved process for the production of recombined milk or cream ”.

Abstract :—

The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1, 6 and 13.

1. A recombined milk product, comprising fat in a content of at least 12 per cent by weight and a low fat milk fraction, said low fat milk fraction containing at least 5 per cent of a low fat milk fraction obtained from genuine milk cream containing at least 20 per cent by weight of butterfat by removing the latter.

6. A process of producing a recombined liquid foodstuff selected from the group consisting of milk and cream which comprises mixing butter with a fluid produced from dried milk powder and water, and homogenising the mixture, the dried milk powder containing a dry powder prepared from a material selected from the group consisting of buttermilk and the low fat milk fraction obtained by centrifugating a cream containing at least 15 per cent fat up to at least 40 per cent and recovering said low fat milk fraction.

13. A dried milk powder for use in a recombining process for making whippable cream, consisting of milk powder prepared from skimmed milk and an addition of at least 10 per cent of a milk powder prepared from a low fat fraction obtained by concentrating the fat content of cream from about 20 per cent up to at least 40 per cent.

Abstract :—

The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1 and 2 which reads as follows :—

1. A sliding door comprising a fixed framework and a sliding framework both of complementary wedge shape cross section in plan with means for guiding the sliding part parallel to the fixed part in the same plane whereby to open or close the wedge, a sealing strip being provided around the perimeter of the wedging surfaces whereby at the said parts are brought together into alignment the sealing strip is compressed to form a seal at the wedge surfaces.

2. A sliding door according to Claim 1 constructed as a unit for application to the entrance of a cold storage or other enclosure and wherein the guide means comprise a fixed rail from which the sliding door part is suspended on anti-friction members and a bottom guide between the bottom edge of the sliding door part and the floor of the door opening, means being provided for adjusting the sliding door part relatively to the fixed door part in a plane at right angles to the sliding plane whereby to vary the sealing pressure between the wedging surfaces.
