## Miscellaneous Departmental Notices

#### IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 22/70

Imports on allocations made under Untied Kingdom/Ceylon Loan of 1970

(THIS NOTICE IS NOT AN INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR IMPORTS UNDER THE ABOVE LOAN AGREEMENT)

IT is proposed to issue licences for imports from the United Kingdom under the above Loan Agreement.

- 2. The procedure applicable in regard to the issue of import licences against allocations for imports under the above loan agreement will be as stated below and will be complementary to those already in force.
  - (i) The importer who receives an allocation for imports under the heading 'United Kingdom/Ceylon Loan, 1970', will negotiate with the supplier in the United Kingdom and obtain from the supplier 4 copies of the Proforma Invoice/Contract duly authenticated by him. The reference number and date of the letter granting the allocation should be quoted on the authenticated Proforma Invoice/Contract in order to identify that the Contract is in respect of supplies covered by the particular allocation. The Proforma Invoice/Contract should also contain a certification by the supplier to the effect that the goods are of U. K. origin and/or specifying the extent of the British content. Three authenticated copies of such Proforma Invoice/Contract should be forwarded to the authority issuing the allocation, i.e., the Import and Export Control Department, Regulation Division/Corporation Division of the Ministry of Industries and Scientific Affairs as the case may be. Action will thereafter be taken by the Import Control Department or Regulation Division/Corporation Division of the Ministry of Industries and Scientific Affairs to issue a licence bearing the heading 'U. K./Ceylon Loan 1970'.
  - (ii) The importer will, on the issuance of such licence, take early steps to open a Letter of Credit with a commercial bank in Ceylon. The commercial bank will arrange for the supplier in the United Kingdom to be paid through its correspondent Bank in the United Kingdom and for the documentation required by the Central Bank of Ceylon.
  - (iii) All goods imported on the authority of licences issued under 'U. K./Ceylon Loan, 1970' should be those wholly produced or manufactured in the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man. In addition to any other documentation, the suppliers should be required to furnish a Payment Notification in the form set out in Appendix 'A' in respect of goods and services covered by the licence and in the form set out in Appendix 'Al' in the case of chemicals and allied producets.
  - 3. It should be noted that-
    - (i) all imports covered by a 'U. K./Ceylon Loan, 1970' licence shall be against Letters of Credit.
    - (ii) Payments for supplies and services financed under licences issued with the heading 'U. K./Ceylon Loan 1970' should be made in sterling only to persons carrying on business in the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man.
    - (iii) where the transaction is on an C.I.F. basis the whole amount will be covered under the loan. In the case of f.o.b. contracts shipping arrangements must be made with a British firm, and insurance, if not effected with the Insurance Corporation of Ceylon, must also be arranged with a British company.
