NOTICE UNDER THE FOOD CONTROL REGULATIONS 1952

IN terms of Regulation 4 Head E Part III of the Food Control Regulations 1952 it is hereby notified for the information of the general public that the following coupons in the 25th series ration books will be valid during the periods mentioned below —

	<i>Period of Validity</i>
Coupons Nos. 4 and 5	14.9.70-25.9.70

Two pounds of rice on each of coupons Nos. 4 and 5 will be issued. These four pounds of rice can be drawn on any day between 14.9.70 and 25.9.70, and will be given free as at present.

	<i>Period of Validity</i>
Coupons Nos. 6 and 7	26.9.70 - 4.10.70

Two pounds of rice will be issued on each coupon of which the two pounds issued on the even numbered coupon will be free while the two pounds issued on the odd numbered coupon will have to be paid for at cents 75. This price will apply throughout the Island.

	<i>Period of Validity</i>
Coupons Nos. 8 and 9	5.10.70 - 11.10.70
Coupons Nos. 10 and 11	12.10.70 - 18.10.70

The arrangements for coupons Nos. 6 and 7 will continue *mutatis mutandis* until further notice.
