THE CEYLON (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946

Order Under Section 61

ORDER made by the Public Service Commission under section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946.

ORDER No. 197

The powers specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto are hereby delegated to the officer specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule, subject to the following conditions:—

- Those powers shall be exercised according to such instructions as may be issued, from time to time, by the Public Service Commission;
- Any person dissatisfied with a decision made by the officer under any power delegated to such officer under this Order may appeal therefrom to the Public Service Commission;
- In any case where the Public Service Commission decides that any power of punishment delegated to such officer shall be exercised by the Public Service Commission, such officer shall not exercise that power in that case.

2. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed or construed to derogate from, or to affect in any other way, the right of appeal to the Public Service Commission conferred by section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946.

3. This Order shall have effect notwithstanding anything in Order No. 83 made under section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, and published in *Gazette* No. 10,847 of October 7, 1955.

4. Nothing in this Order shall affect in any way any power of punishment already delegated by the Public Service Commission under section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, and published in the *Gazette* from time to time, nor any power of punishment that may be delegated hereafter.

5. The power of appointment delegated by the Item No. 1 in the Schedule hereto shall not affect in any way any power of appointment already delegated by the Public Service Commission under section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946 and published in the *Gazette* from time to time, or any power of appointment that may be delegated hereafter.

6. The Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service referred to in Column I of the Schedule hereto, is the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service dated July 25, 1968, and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,811/7 of July 26, 1968, as subsequently amended by Notifications published in the *Gazette* from time to time.

7. The Order No. 192 dated January 28, 1970, made by the Public Service Commission under section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, and published in *Gazette* No. 14,893 of February 13, 1970 is hereby revoked.

1. The power to make appointments to the posts enumerated in Class III of the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and to other posts that may be included from time to time.

The Head of the Department in which the appointment is to be made.

2. The power to make appointments to the posts enumerated in Classes I, IA and II of the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and to other posts that may be included from time to time, in respect of Departments assigned to a Minister but excluding the Department of Public Administration.

The Senior Assistant Secretary to the Ministry.

Where there is no separate post of Senior Assistant Secretary, the Assistant Secretary in charge of the subject.

3. The power to make appointments to the posts enumerated in Classes I, IA and II of the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and to other posts that may be included from time to time, in respect of the Office of the Prime Minister.

The Senior Assistant Secretary to the Ministry of Defence and External Affairs.

4. The power to make appointments to the posts enumerated in Classes I, IA and II of the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and to other posts that may be included from time to time, in the Department of the Auditor-General.

The Senior Deputy Auditor-General.

5. The power to make appointments to the posts enumerated in Classes I, IA and II of the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and to other posts that may be included from time to time, in the Department of Elections. The Commissioner of Elections (Parliamentary and Local Bodies).
6. The power to make appointments to the posts enumerated in Classes I, IA and II of the Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employee's Service and to other posts that may be included from time to time, in respect of the following Departments :—
The Director-General of Public Administration
(a) Department of Public Administration.
(b) Cabinet Office.
(c) Office of the Judicial Service Commission.
(d) Office of the Public Service Commission.
(e) Office of the Leader of the House of Representatives.
(f) Office of the Leader of the Opposition of the House of Representatives.
7. The power to dismiss or otherwise punish for misconduct any of the employees holding posts enumerated in Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and other posts that may be included from time to time, on any ground other than on the ground of conviction. The Head of the Department.
8. The power to reprimand or to reprimand severely, or to punish with a fine not exceeding one week's pay or with suspension, stoppage, reduction or deferment of increment for a period not exceeding one year, on any ground, other than on the ground of conviction, any of the employees holding posts enumerated in Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and other posts that may be included from time to time. The Head of the Department.
9. The power to retire any of the employees holding posts enumerated in Schedule 'S' of the Minute on the Office Employees' Service and other posts that may be included from time to time, who have reached the age of optional retirement. The Appointing Authority.
