THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Illecutti Oliver Kenneth Gamini Fernando, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Tooth Paste Tubes) Order No. 1 of 1970.
- 2. This Order shall apply to the whole island.
- 3. For the purposes of this Order:-
 - (1) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto, to a trader for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of an article specified in Columns 1 and 2 of that Schedule in any quantity not less than two dozen at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale; and
 - (2) any sale of an article specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto, in any quantity less than two dozen for the purpose of consumption or use, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail.
- 4. The prices specified in each entry in Columns 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto, shall with effect from 1st October, 1970, be the manufacturer's maximum wholesale price, the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price and the retail dealer's maximum retail price per tube of tooth paste to the consumer, respectively, above which any tubes of tooth paste of the description set out in the corresponding entries in Columns 1 and 2 of that Schedule shall not be sold;
- 5. Every trader who has for purposes of sale, any quantity of tubes of tooth paste of the description specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto, in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the brand names of the tubes of tooth paste and in figures not less than one inch in height, the maximum price of such tubes of tooth paste fixed by this Order so as to be clearly seen by any customer;
- 6. Every person who sells any tubes of tooth paste of the description set out in Columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto by wholesale or retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the description and the number of tubes of tooth paste sold;
 - (c) the price charged for the number of tubes of tooth paste sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- 7. Every person carrying on business as a wholesale or retail trader in any tooth paste of the description set out in Columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall furnish to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15th of October, 1970, a return specifying—
 - (a) the stocks of tubes of tooth paste in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made; and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept; and
- 8. The maximum price specified in each of the Columns 3. 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such tube of tooth paste is sold.

 - (1) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, to a trader for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of an article specified in Column 1 of that Schedule in any quantity not less than two dozen at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale; and
 - (2) any sale of an article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, in any quantity less than two dozens for the purpose of consumption or uso, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail.
- 4. The prices specified in each entry in Columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, shall with effect from 1st October, 1970, be he manufacturer's maximum wholesale price, the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price and the retail dealer's maximum retail price per flash light battery or per transistor radio battery, as the case may be to the consumer, respectively, above which a flash light battery or a transistor battery of the description set out in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of that Schedule shall not be sold.

Every trader who has for purposes of sale, any flash light batteries or transistor radio batteries of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the brand name of the flash light batteries and transistor radio batteries and in figures not less than one inch in height, the maximum price of such flash light batteries and transistor radio batteries fixed by this Order so as to be clearly seen by any customer.
- 6. Every person who sells any flash light batteries or transistor radio batteries of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto by wholesale or retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the description and the number of flash light batteries or trasnistor radio batteries sold;
 - (c) the price charged for the number of batteries sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.
- 7. Every person carrying on business as a wholesale or retail trader in flash light batteries or transistor radio batteries of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall furnish to the Depurty Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15th October, 1970, a return specifying—
 - (a) the stocks of such flash light batteries and transistor radio batteries in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made, and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept; and
- The maximum price specified in each of the Columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such flash light batteries or transistor radio batteries are sold.

- Every person who solls any umbrellas of the description set out in the Column 1 of the Schedule hereto by wholesale or retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out-
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the description and the number of umbrellas sold;
 - (c) the price charged for the number of umbrellas sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.
- 7. Every person carrying on business as a wholesale or retail trader in any umbrellas of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall furnish to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15th October, 1970, a return specifying-
 - (a) the stocks of such umbrellas in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made; and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept.
- 8. The maximum price specified in each of the Columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such umbrella is sold.
