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## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, November 10, 1899.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated November 4, 1899.

*Present*:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Allan Perry; the Hon. Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Hariffa; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; and Mr. H. A. Jayawardene.

The Minutes of October 13, 1899, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of October 13, 1899, be confirmed.

1. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of October 20 and November 7, 1899, were laid before the Council:—

*October 20, 1899.*

(7) Memorandum from Secretary suggesting the transfer of the sum of Rs. 100 from vote 90, General Cemetery, Kanatta, Salary of Keeper, to vote 95, Contingencies, to provide for the cost of tools, &c., for the General Cemetery, Kanatta

Resolved that the Council be recommended to transfer under section 114 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887 the sum of Rs. 100 from vote 90, General Cemetery, Kanatta, Salary of Keeper, to vote 95, Contingencies.

- (8) Memorandum from Secretary, suggesting the transfer of the sum of Rs. 50 from vote 15, Commission, &c., to vote 16, Tin Plates and Painting.  
Resolved that the Council be recommended to transfer under section 114 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887 the sum of Rs. 50 from vote 15, Commission, &c., to vote 16, Tin Plates and Painting.
- (10) Application from Mr. M. Cochran, Gas Inspector and City Analyst, for one year's leave.  
Resolved that the Council be advised to grant Mr. M. Cochran, Gas Inspector and City Analyst, one year's leave of absence, provided that he makes arrangements for the pay of his *locum tenens*, and provided that Mr. T. Cockerill consents to act for him.
- (43) Tender for the lease of the Grandpass market for 1900.  
Resolved that the tender of Rs. 470 per mensem from Mr. J. G. G. Abeyasingha be recommended to the Council.
- (44) Tenders for the lease of the river frontage and watcher's hut near the late bridge-of-boats for 1900.  
Resolved that the highest tender, namely, that of Rs. 32 per mensem, from K. S. Dias, be recommended to the Council.
- (45) Tenders for the lease of the late Superintendent of Bridge-of-boats' quarters at Grandpass for 1900.  
Resolved that the tender of Mr. J. G. G. Abeyasingha for Rs. 65 per mensem be recommended to the Council.

November 7, 1899.

- (11) Tenders for the lease of the mutton market, Slave Island, for 1900.  
Resolved that the tender of Rs. 150 per mensem from Chappon Ahamat be recommended to the Council.  
Resolved further that the lessee be directed to set apart one stall for the sale of offal.
- (13) Tenders for the lease of St. John's fish market for 1900.  
Resolved that the highest tender, namely, that of Rs. 250 per mensem, from H. Jacolis Perera, be recommended to the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that the recommendations contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted."

Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa seconded.—Carried unanimously.

2. A report dated November 3, 1899, of the Special Committee appointed to consider and report upon the advisability of acquiring land for widening the Maradana road and extending Dean's road market was laid before Council.

Mr. C. Pererera moved "that the report and connected papers be circulated."

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried unanimously.

3. A report dated November 6, 1899, of the Special Committee on lighting with reference to lighting the town with incandescent gas was laid before Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be adopted."

The Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne seconded.—Carried unanimously.

4. An application from Mr. P. N. Kapadia for permission to retain the Parsee theatrical shed standing at the Racquet Court till the end of December, 1899, with connected papers, was laid before Council.

Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa moved "that the application be allowed."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.

5. Report of the Sanitary Officer for the third quarter of 1899 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

6. A statement of receipts and disbursements from January 1 to October 31, 1899, and a progress report of work done for October, 1899, were laid on the table.
