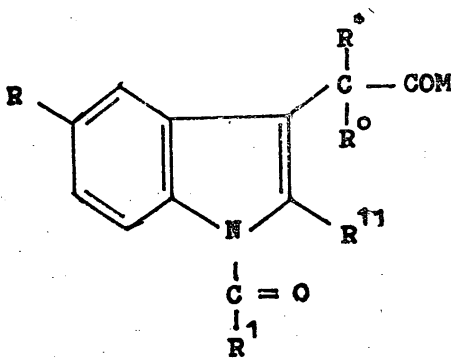

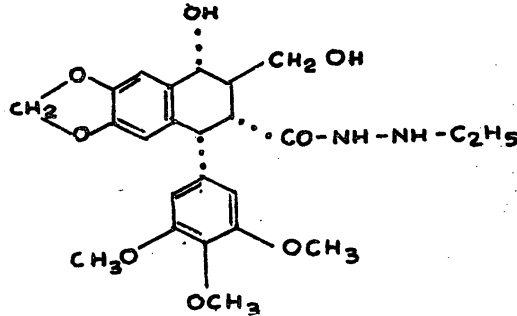

A closure for a bottle or like container of the kind referred to comprising a one-piece cup-like member the skirt of which includes an upper portion adapted with the base of the said member to provide a re-closure for the container, a lower portion adapted to provide a security ring and an intermediate outwardly dished portion weakened to permit ready separation of the upper and lower portions, the upper and the lower portions being adapted respectively to co-operate with screw thread formations of opposite hand on the container when the closure is in operative position on the container and the internal diameter of the upper portion of the skirt being less than the internal diameter of the lower portion of the skirt so that after separation of the upper and lower portions the lower portion can be removed from the container by movement lengthwise thereof.

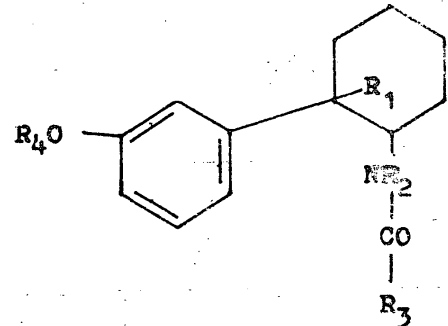

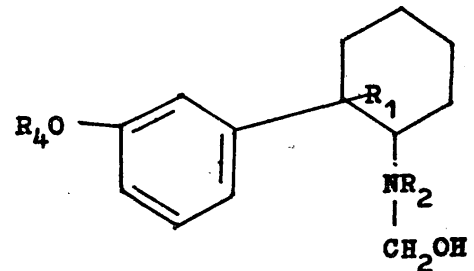
