MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, March 9, 1900.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated March 3, 1900.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Mr. Allan Perry; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Stanley Bois; Mr. A. Forsyth; Mr. A. de A. Senevirātne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayawardene; and Mr. John Caderamen.

The Minutes of February 9, 1900, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of February 9, 1900, be confirmed.

1. The following extract from Minutes of the Standing Committee of February 21, 1900, was laid before the Council:—

February 21, 1900.

(47) Application from the widow of late E. C. Palle, Supervisor, Health Department, for a gratuity. Resolved that the Council be recommended to grant a gratuity of Rs. 300 to the widow and two children.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that the recommendation contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted."

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried unanimously.

2. A report of the Special Committee dated February 26, 1900, on the revision of by-laws re-appointed on January 19, 1900, with reference to the Draft Ordinance bringing into force the revised by-laws adopted by the Council, and the Attorney General's report on it, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that the consideration of the report be deferred for the Special Meeting to be held on the 15th instant."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.

3. A letter No. 13/2188 of February 8, 1900, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding a copy of the report of the Commission appointed to inquire and report on the accidents which have occurred owing to contact with electric wires connected with the Colombo Tramway Service, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be referred to the Special Committee appointed to consider, *inter alia*, rules in connection with the tramways, and that application be made to Government for a copy of the appendices referred to in the report."

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried unanimously.

4. Applications for the post of Assistant Municipal Engineer were laid before the Council, having been previously circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Mr. S. W. Dassanaik be appointed Assistant Municipal Engineer."

Mr. F. H. Grinlinton seconded.—Carried unanimously.

5. An application from Mr. N. B. Cooray, 2nd Accountant, Health Department, for an extension of leave from March 8 to 31, 1900, was laid before the Council.

Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa moved "that the leave applied for be allowed."

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried unanimously.

6. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to December 31, 1899, and from January 1 to 31 and from January 1 to February 28, 1900, and Progress Reports of Work done for December, 1899, and January and February, 1900, were laid on the table.

7. Report of Sanitary Officer for the fourth quarter of 1899 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

8. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for October, 1899, were laid on the table.

9. The City Analyst's report on the town water for February, 1900, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

10. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poison, and gun-powder for February, 1900, were laid on the table.
