MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, April 6, 1900.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated March 31, 1900.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Stanley Bois; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; and Mr. John Caderamen.

The Minutes of March 9 and 15, 1900, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of March 9 and 15, 1900, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. Perera asked—Whether a memorial in regard to the proposed establishment of plumbago works in premises No. 105, 2nd Division, Maradana, had been received by the Chairman.

The Chairman replied—That such a memorial had been received on the 26th ultimo; that it had been on the same day referred to the Council's lawyers for their advice; and that on the 5th instant he had received Council's opinion that the Chairman cannot do anything as things now stand.

2. The following motion standing in Mr. C. Perera's name was, by leave of Council, withdrawn:—To move that the memorial referred to in the preceding question be laid on the table and considered.

3. A report, dated April 2, 1900, of the Special Committee appointed to consider letter A of March 7, 1900, from the Chairman of the Commission on Sanitary Improvements in Colombo, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved "that the report be adopted."

Major Knollys seconded.—Carried. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy dissenting to the adoption of the second paragraph of the Committee's report.

4. A statement of receipts and disbursements from January 1 to March 31, 1900, and progress report of work done for March, 1900, were laid on the table.

5. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for November, 1899, were laid on the table.

6. The City Analyst's report on the town water for March, 1900, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

7. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder for March, 1900, were laid on the table.
