  - (i) land lying within a radius of one mile from St.
    Anne's Church, Talawila, and
  - (ii) land lying within a distance of fifty yards from either side of the road leading from Palakudah to Talawila;
- "Government Agent" means the Government Agent of the Puttalam District and any officer duly authorised by him to act on his behalf.
- 2. No person shall camp in any place within the camp area where camping is prohibited by special or general order of the Government Agent.
- 3. No person shall ease himself within the camp area except at the places provided for that purpose by, or with the approval of the Government Agent.
- 4. No person shall deposit any liquid or solid refuse, or any rubbish, within the camp area, except in the places or receptacles provided for that purpose by, or with the approval of the Government Agent.
- 5. (a) No cattle shall be kept within the camp area except those brought there for slaughter and those permitted by special or general order of the Government Agent, to be kept within such area.
- (b) No cattle shall be kept in the vicinity of the camp area except at a place specially set up as a cattle gala or at a place approved in that behalf by the Government Agent.
- (c) The person in charge of the cattle shall cause their droppings to be removed to the nearest place provided therefor and shall at all times keep clean the place occupied by the cattle.
- (d) No person shall park any vehicle within the camp area except at the places provided for that purpose by or with the approval of the Government Agent. A person desiring to park a vehicle at any other place shall obtain a special permit from the Government Agent. No person shall establish a park for cars or other vehicles unless the rates to be charged for parking of such vehicles are approved by the Government Agent.
- 6. All prepared foods sold within the camp area shall be protected from flies and dust by being (a) wrapped in or covered with clean paper or cloth, or (b) kept in closed glass cases or (c) kept in other covered containers approved by the Medical Officer or by the Public Health Inspector in charge of the camp area.
- 7. No person who is likely to affect prejudicially the cleanliness of the camp area, and no person who is suffering from an infectious disease shall be permitted to cater in the camp area.
- 8. In the event of an epidemic breaking out in the camp area during the festival the Government Agent may direct the pilgrims to leave the place of pilgrimage and may prescribe the routes and methods of their departure.

- 9. Every person within the camp area who is suffering from an infectious disease or a contagious disease and every person who resides with him knowing that he is so suffering shall report the case to the Medical Officer or the Public Health Inspector in charge of the camp area.
- 10. When any tank or well within the camp area is set apart for any particular purpose and a notice to that effect is exhibited on the spot, no person shall use that tank or well for any purpose other than that for which it is set apart.
- 11. No person shall keep any bakery, aerated water manufactory, sherbert or ice-cream stall, tea or coffee boutique, eating house or any boutique where prepared food is exposed for sale without previously obtaining a licence from the Government Agent permitting him to do so. The licence shall be issued free of charge.
- 12. No. person shall, without the previous sanction of the Government Agent, discharge fireworks or firearms within the camp area or within a radius of one mile from the boundaries of such area.
- 13. No person shall, without the previous sanction of the Government Agent, construct any booth or any building within the camp area so as to encroach upon any main or other streets of the camp.
- 14. (1) No person shall slaughter any animal within the camp area except in the place provided for that purpose by or with the approval of the Government Agent, and any person slaughtering any animal in such a place shall be responsible for its cleanliness. Animals to be slaughtered should be pounded for 24 hours and shall be passed by the Public Health Inspector to ensure that the animal is free from disease and the meat is fit for human consumption.
- (2) No person shall sell any meat, fish or vegetable within the camp area except in a place provided for the purpose by or with the approval of the Government Agent; and no person shall sell any meat, fish or vegetable that is unfit for human consumption or has in any way lost its freshness due to long keeping or improper storage.
- 15. The regulations relating to St. Anne's Festivals, Talawila, published in *Gazette* No. 9,626 of November 8, 1946, and *Gazette* No. 10,853 of August 28, 1953, are hereby rescinded.

## Award

The Honourable the Minister of Labour and Employment, by his order dated 9th March, 1968, under section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon (1956 Revised Edition), as amended by Acts Nos. 14 of 1957, 62 of 1957 and 4 of 1962, referred this dispute to this Tribunal for settlement by arbitration,

Part I: Sec. (I) — (General) — CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE — Dec. 18, 1970

The statement of the matters in dispute accompanying the reference by the Commissioner of Labour states the disputes as follows:—

"Whether the termination of the services of Mr. Dixie Thamoderam by the management of Ocean Foods and Trades (C. & J.) Ltd., is justified and to what relief is Mr. Dixie Thamoderam entitled."

When this matter was taken up for inquiry on 3.11.70 Mr. Vernon Livera represented the applicant union and Mr. N. K. Choksey instructed by Messrs. Mather and Ramanathan appeared for the respondent-company.

Of consent, parties came to the following settlement:-

- (a) The respondent-company offered to pay to the workman concerned a sum of Rs. 600 as an ex-gratia payment in full and final settlement of all claims the applicant has against the company.
- (b) The respondent-company also agreed to furnish the workman concerned with a certificate of service giving details such as date of joining, date of leaving, the last salary paid, position held as an electrician and that he was hard working and enterprising.

The applicant-union and the workman concerned accepted the above offer.

It is a just and equitable settlement and I make award accordingly.

The respondent-company shall deposit this sum of Rs. 600 together with the certificate of service referred to in para. (b) above in favour of the workman concerned with the Assistant Commissioner of Labour, Colombo South, Labour Secretariat, Narahenpita, within two weeks of the date of this award.

The workman concerned, Mr. Dixie Thamodaram, is at liberty to withdraw them once the deposit has been made by the respondent-company.
