THE STAMP ORDINANCE

RULE made by the Minister of Finance, under section 6 of the Stamp Ordinance (Chapter 247).

Rule

The rule made under section 6 of the Stamp Ordinance (Chapter 247), and published in *Gazette* No. 14,707 of August 5, 1966, as last amended by rule published in *Gazette* No. 14,933 of November 20, 1970, is hereby further amended in the Schedule thereto, by the insertion, immediately after item 84, of the following new item:—

“ 85. Postage and Revenue Stamps in the 15 cents denomination issued to commemorate the International Education Year 1970. The picture on the stamp of an ola leaf manuscript signifies a great education event which took place in the years 455 to 467 of the Buddhist Era when Tripitaka (the collection of Pali books containing the teachings of the Lord Buddha), was committed to writing. An abstract head of man illuminated by knowledge is also depicted by concentric circles ”.
