##### THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE

###### Order Under Section 84

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 84 of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262), I, Felix Reginald Dias Bandaranaike, Minister of Public Administration, Local Government and Home Affairs do by this Order declare that all steps hereofore taken under section 26 of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance for the purpose of nominating candidates in respect of Wards Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of the Madampe Village Council in the Galle District in connection with the general election which was due to be held before December 31, 1970, shall be, and shall at all times be deemed to have been void and of no effect whatsoever.

###### Order

1. The Elections Officer for the District of Colombo shall, for the purpose of the general election of the members of the Kotte Urban Council which is due to be held on or before February 28, 1971, take the steps required by sections 26 and 38 of the said Local Authorities Elections Ordinance for the purpose of the said general election on such dates as may be determined by him in the exercise of his discretion having regard to the date on which the term of office of the members of the said Urban Council is due to commence.

2. Notwithstanding anything in the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262), no electoral lists shall be prepared for the purposes of the aforesaid general election and the electoral lists to be used for the purposes of the said general election shall be the electoral lists which were certified by the Elections Officer of the District of Colombo on July 19, 1970.

**Order**

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262)—

- (a) the notices under sections 38 and 41 of that Ordinance published by the Elections Officer of the District in which each electoral area specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto is situated, specifying December 4, 1970, as the date on which a poll will be taken for the purpose of electing a member for each of the wards specified in column II of the Schedule hereto, shall be and shall at all times be deemed to have been void and of no effect whatsoever; and
- (b) the Elections Officer for the District in which each such electoral area is situated shall publish a fresh notice under the aforesaid sections specifying another date for the purpose of taking a poll in respect of each such ward.
