THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE

Order under section 84

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 84 of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262), I, Felix Reginald Dias Bandaranaike, Minister of Public Administration, Local Government and Home Affairs, do by this Order declare that—

- (a) the notices dated December 3, 1970, published by the Elections Officer, Kalutara District, under sections 38 and 41 of that Ordinance specifying the 19th day of December, 1970, as the date on which a poll will be taken for the purpose of electing a member for each of the following wards, that is to say, Wards Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the Beruwala Urban Council, in so far as those notices relate to the date on which, the hours between which, and the situation of each of the polling stations at which, a poll will be taken for the purpose of the election of a member for each of the aforesaid wards, shall be, and shall at all times be deemed to have been, void and of no effect whatsoever; and
- (b) the Elections Officer, Kalutara District, shall, having regard to the date on which the term of office of the members of the aforesaid Urban Council who are now in office is due to expire, publish fresh notices under the aforesaid sections specifying another date on which, the hours between which, and the situation of each of the polling stations at which, a poll will be taken for the purpose of the election of a member for each of the aforesaid wards.
