THE KANDY MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

The Municipal Councils Ordinance, No. 29 of 1947

IT is hereby notified that I, the Special Commissioner of Kandy Town, in terms of section 305 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, Chapter 252, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, resolved—

- (1) that the following revised annual licence fees shall be charged for the dangerous or offensive trades mentioned hereunder, in lieu of the rates of fees specified therefor in Part I of the Schedule appended to the Proclamation published in *Gazette* No. 10,197 of January 5, 1951, and *Gazette* No. 11,253 of January 31, 1958 ; and
- (2) that the following revised annual licence fees shall be charged for the dangerous or offensive trades mentioned hereunder, in lieu of the rates of fees specified therefor in Part II of the Schedule appended to the Proclamation published in *Gazette* No. 10,197 of January 5, 1951, and *Gazette* No. 11,253 of January 31, 1958.
