ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT PUBLIC SERVICE PROVIDENT FUND FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1967/68

MANAGEMENT.—During the year under review the Fund sanctioned under the Ministry of Finance. With effect from May 31, 1970, the administration of the Fund has been assigned to the Ministry of Public Administration, Local Government and Home affairs by notification under Section 46(4) of the Ceylon (Constitution Orders in Council, 1946, and 1947 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,908/8 of June 2, 1970. In consequence of this assignment the Director of Pensions has been appointed Chairman of the Board of Management.

REPORT OF THE AUDITOR-GENERAL ON THE ACCOUNTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE PROVIDENT FUND FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 1968

(Figures in this report have been rounded off to the nearest rupee)

The accounts of the Public Service Provident Fund for the year ended September 30, 1968 were audited under my direction in pursuance of Section 24 (1) of the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance (Cap. 434).

2. The undermentioned financial statements for the year ended September 30, 1968 were rendered by the Secretary, Board of Management, Public Service Provident Fund on January 26, 1972 for audit.

- (i) A statement of Receipts and Payments for the year ended September 30, 1968.
- (ii) Income Appropriation Account for the year ended September 30, 1968.
- (iii) Balance Sheet as at September 30, 1968.

My observations arising from the audit of the accounts are given below :

OUTCOME OF ACCOUNTS

3. According to the Income Appropriation Account the income of the fund for the year under review amounted to Rs. 2,391,896 and the expenditure for the year amounted to Rs. 2,369,067 comprising Rs. 2,136,605 being interest allowed to contributors at 3½% on the minimum monthly balances and Rs. 232,462 being the cost of establishment and the depreciation on furniture and equipment. The working result for the year was a surplus of Rs. 22,829. In arriving at this Surplus a sum of Rs. 8,750 being the loss on realisation of Rs. 352,800 3½% Home Defence Loan 1963-68 had not been charged to the Income Appropriation Account, but to the Investment Reserve Account. This surplus together with the un-appropriated balance of Rs. 79,921 brought forward from the previous year totalled to Rs. 102,750. This sum of Rs. 102,750 was carried forward to the following year.

STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS

Receipts :

4. Government share of Contributions—Rs. 3,450,000.—Section 7 (1) of the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance requires the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury to credit to the General Account of the Fund at the close of each financial year a sum equivalent to one and a half times the aggregate of the compulsory contributions made by contributors during that financial year. On the total compulsory contributions of Rs. 1,901,995 received during the year the amount payable by the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury was Rs. 2,852,993 but Rs. 3,450,000 had been paid. The sum of Rs. 597,007 paid in excess was refunded to the Consolidated Fund in September, 1971.

Payments :

5. Awards to Contributors—Rs. 2,481,475.—358 vouchers for payments totalling Rs. 72,498 included in the above Rs. 2,481,475 have not been made available for audit up to April 15, 1972.

GENERAL

6. Registers of Recoveries.—Regulation 9 (x) framed under the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance requires that all departments and accounting units should forward in respect of each financial year duly reconciled registers of recoveries to the Secretary, Board of Management, Public Service Provident Fund, by not later than October 31, of the following year. However, four registers in respect of the Education Department for the period 1961-62 to 1964-65 had not been received by the Public Service Provident Fund Office as at April 1, 1972.

In the absence of these registers, the requirement of Regulation 8 (z) framed under the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance that the totals shown in the registers of recoveries of each department or accounting unit should be reconciled with the amounts actually credited to the fund during the year in respect of that department or accounting unit could not be complied with.

7. *Individual Contributors' Accounts.*—Individual Contributors' Accounts are not being maintained by the Fund. The individual account of any contributor is prepared only at the time of disposing of the balance standing to his credit in the fund. In the circumstances, the total of the balances lying to the credit of contributors as at any date cannot be ascertained.

In the absence of the individual accounts, the reconciliation of the balance standing to the credit of the contribution account in the main ledger as at the end of any financial year with the aggregate of the balances in the individual accounts as at the same date cannot be done. Similarly, a reconciliation of the total of the interest allowed to individual contributors for any year with the amount charged to the Income Appropriation Account for that year also cannot be done.

8. *Information to Contributors.*—Section 25 of the Public Service Provident Fund Ordinance requires the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury to inform each contributor, as soon as practicable after the close of each financial year, of the total amount standing to his credit in the fund at the end of that financial year. This requirement has not been complied with in respect of any year since the establishment of the fund in 1942. In order to comply with this statutory requirement it is essential that the individual contributors accounts should be written up early.
