The Minister of Labour by virtue of the powers vested in him by Section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act with the amendments thereto has referred the following dispute to me for settlement by arbitration.

The matter in dispute is as follows:—

Whether the non-offer of work to the following workers by Mr. R. G. Raju is justified and to what relief each of them is entitled:—

1. L. P. Nonis Appuhamy.
2. W. A. Asilin Nona.
3. T. A. Deen.
4. R. A. D. Premawathie.
5. W. Wimalawathie Perera.
6. K. Arumugam.
7. W. K. Lambert.
8. L. Sirisena.
9. W. A. Premawathie.
10. D. P. Sirisena.
11. G. K. Ranbanda.
12. K. Jayawardene.
13. W. D. Baris.
14. Thuwan Aziz.
15. H. M. Hussain.

The 15 employees in question had been employed at various periods from 1961 to 1968, but in 1968 they were in permanent employment. In September, 1970, the services of the women were terminated and on 4th November, the men were discontinued. They had not been given any kind of written notice of the termination of their services. It is admitted by Mr. Raju, the Managing Director that these workmen were employed in his establishment, but denied that he was the owner of the

premises or the business. His position was that he was a Rubber Packing Contractor for Hamza Davoodbhoy and that he was paid one cent for every pound of rubber packed and shipped. He also tried to make out that Hamza Davoodbhoy paid the rent for the premises. He had started this business from October 1958. He unwittingly admitted that he employed the labour, but Hamza Davoodbhoy paid them. It was also surprising that the Employees Provident Fund had been deducted from 1959 by Raju. It was suggested by Mr. Raju that Hamza Davoodbhoy fled the country leaving all, lock stock and barrel, and his whereabouts are known only to the Gods in Heaven.

Raju says that he never bought any rubber except the packing of it for a third person. He paid the E. P. F. of the workers out of the one cent per pound that was paid to him by Hamza Davoodbhoy.

Raju has started another business in the same premises. He apparently has re-employed some of his favourites. If the rent for these premises had been paid by Davoodbhoy, the easiest thing for Raju is to produce some of the Rent Receipts. Further, if he was doing this business on the contract of packing, he should produce the Books of Accounts to satisfy me of his assertions. I am not at all prepared to accept his 'Ipse Dixit'. I could seldom find such a shrewd and slippery business-man like Raju. It appears to me, whatever he did, he did as his own and the workers looked upon him as their Master and Pay Master.

One wonders whether Davoodbhoy is in this picture; it is easy now to father everything, deeds and misdeeds, on Davoodbhoy and to escape liability. That is not so easy before this Court.

I am satisfied on the evidence before me that Raju employed these workmen and he paid them and that the business was his. Further, Raju has failed to discharge the burden imposed on him.

In these circumstances, I have nothing but to call upon Raju to pay the compensation due to these discontinued workmen. That is their present request.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

WHEAT FLOUR

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me, by section 4 read with section 3(2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Kapila Pathirana Wimaladharma, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for Kegalla District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect the Food Price Order No. K.E. 128 dated April 22, 1968, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,798/6 of April 25, 1968;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the price specified in column 2 of the first schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per 148lbs. nett above which wheat flour shall not be sold by wholesale by the wholesale dealers mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule;
- (iii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the second schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per lb. nett above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any wheat flour for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of wheat flour in a quantity of 148lbs. nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour less than 148lbs. nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) "Wheat" flour shall be deemed to include a mixture of wheat flour with maize flour;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell wheat flour which is mixed with any other articles except maize flour;
- (vi) direct that no person shall sell any mixture of wheat flour and maize flour which contains more than ten per cent. by weight of maize flour;
- (vii) direct that when any wheat flour is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such wheat flour is sold;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of wheat flour in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for wheat flour fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the wheat flour and the maximum price could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (ix) direct that for the purpose of this Order "Pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be a standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (x) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells wheat flour by wholesale shall, and every person who sells wheat flour by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of wheat flour sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (xi) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of wheat flour which is less than or more than 148 lbs. nett and sold by wholesale should, as usual, be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per 148lbs. nett.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), read with the Section 3 (2) of the Act I, Kapila Pathirana Wimaladharma, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for Kegalle District, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke with immediate effect Food Price Order No. KE 125 dated 27th November 1967, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 14,776/10 of November 27, 1967.
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which bread shall not be sold in 16oz. loaves and in 8 oz. loaves respectively within the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that any loaf weighing more than 8 oz. or any part more than 8 oz. in weight of any loaf shall not be sold in any area at a price higher than the price calculated proportionately by weight from the maximum price per 16 oz. loaf fixed by this Order for that area;
- (4) direct that any loaf weighing not more than 8 oz. or any part not more than 8 oz. in weight of any loaf shall not be sold in any area at a price higher than the price calculated proportionately by weight from the maximum price per 8 oz. loaf fixed by the Order for that area;
- (5) direct that when any bread is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper, if any in which such bread is sold;
- (6) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has bread in his possession at any premises, shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of bread;
- (7) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any bread shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,
 - (b) the description of the loaf sold,
 - (c) the quantity of bread sold, and
 - (d) the price paid for the bread sold,
- (8) direct that for the purpose of this Order "oz." shall be deemed to be the standard ounce avoirdupois weight.

THE Accounts of the Local Loans and Development Fund for the year ended September 30, 1971 were audited under my direction and this report is submitted in accordance with Section 14 of the Local Loans and Development Ordinance (Cap. 404).

2. *Financial Review*—(i) *Financial Results*.—The working of the fund for the year ended September 30, 1971 resulted in a net loss of Rs. 727,760.

3. *Arrears*.—The position with regard to repayment of loans and payment of interest by certain local authorities continued to be unsatisfactory in spite of the Cabinet decision in May, 1971 that the local authorities should be called upon to pay up their arrears within six months. Although this time limit ended on December 31, 1971 there has not been any appreciable improvement in the position of the arrears. No finality has been reached as to how the local authorities who are in arrears could be compelled to repay the loans.

LOCAL LOANS AND DEVELOPMENT FUND

Report for the year—1970/1971

THE Statement of Accounts for the year ended September 30, 1971 and the Balance Sheet as at that date are submitted on with this Report.

2. *Interest Received.*—The rate of interest on loans granted by the Fund was increased from 7% to 9½% per annum with effect from 1st January, 1971. The total interest received during the year on loans granted was Rs. 2,648,942.63, as against Rs. 2,318,633.56 in 1969/70.

3. *Interest Paid.*—The rate of interest on sums borrowed from Government increased from 6½% to 9½% per annum with effect from 01.01.71. The total interest paid by the Fund on loans obtained was Rs. 3,371,437 as against Rs. 3,142,245, in 1969/70.

4. *Loans Granted.*—During the year the Fund paid a sum of Rs. 3,822,482 as loans to various Local Authorities, as against Rs. 6,154,276 granted during 1969/70.

5. *Borrowings by the Fund and Repayments.*—During the year, the Fund borrowed a sum of Rs. 5,500,000 from Government. The Fund repaid a sum of Rs. 5,830,640 on loans obtained from Government in previous years. The total indebtedness of the Fund as at September 30, 1971 is Rs. 91,975,360 to Government, and Rs. 750,000 to the Savings Certificates Fund, making a total of Rs. 92,725,360, shown in the statement of Liabilities and Assets.

A sum of Rs. 9,500,000 was also placed in deposit by the Treasury, to meet commitments of the Fund which are expected to mature in 1971/72.

6. *Repayments of Loans granted by the Fund.*—A sum of Rs. 4,954,012 was received by way of repayment of loans already granted by the Fund. At the close of the Financial Year, there was a balance of Rs. 96,230,869.53, due on this account from Local Authorities. A statement showing the details of the make up of this amount is annexed to this report—statement F. This is the first time that such a statement of reconciliation supporting the total figure of Rs. 96,230,869.53 due from Local Authorities has been prepared for the purpose of the Annual Accounts.

7. *Arrears of Re-payments—(1) Co-operative Societies.*—A sum of Rs. 159,596.20, which represented the amount of capital outstanding on loans granted to Co-operative Societies several years ago, was appropriated from funds voted by Parliament for the settlement of these loans, and the corresponding loan accounts in the books of the Fund were thereby closed. There is yet a sum of Rs. 125,628.29 outstanding in the books of the fund, as interest due from these Societies, most of which are, according to the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, in the process of liquidation. He is now taking action to recover as much of the arrears as possible, by the disposal of the Assets of these Societies. Till such time, the Interest accounts will be kept open. Action will then be taken to waive the balances of these interest accounts, with the authority of the Hon. Minister of Finance.

(2) *Local Authorities.*—As mentioned in the Reports of the previous years, although the interest due on loans obtained by the Local Authorities which participated in the Towns South of Colombo Water Supply Scheme, became payable when the headworks were completed in 1966, the Local Authorities concerned have not yet settled these dues. Whilst there is delay on the part of these Local Authorities to pay the interest on their loans, the Fund continues to pay over Rs. 550,000 per year, as interest due to Government on the loans obtained by the Fund on this account.

The Statement marked 'D' shows the Local Authorities which are in arrears in regard to Loans and interest as at 31.12.71. The authority of the Cabinet was sought to take certain steps to enable the Fund to recover its dues from the Local Authorities concerned. The Cabinet decided that Local Authorities should be called upon to pay up their arrears within six months. This period ended on 31.12.1971, but there is no evidence that any serious effort has been made to settle arrears. The Commissioners may therefore have to consider taking the drastic step of invoking the provisions of Section 18 of the Local Loans and Development Ordinance, (Cap. 404), in order that the rates and taxes of the errant Local Authorities could be appropriated in settlement of the amounts due.

8. *Losses.*—The failure on the part of the Local Authorities to pay their dues has resulted in the Fund, for the fifth year in succession, incurring a loss in its year's working. The loss for 1970/71 is Rs. 727,759.60 as against Rs. 828,469.22 in the previous year. The loss for 1970/71 has finally exhausted the accumulated profits of previous years and converted the latter into an accumulated loss of Rs. 10,124 carried forward to 1971/72.

9. *Statement of Business done.*—The statement marked 'E' gives an indication of the business done during the last ten years.

10. The Commissioners mention with pleasure and wish to place on record their appreciation of the work done by the staff to complete the accounts for the year 1970/71 earlier than last year.
