THE STATE INDUSTRIAL CORPORATION ACT, No. 49 OF 1957

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT.

Order under Section 4

Food Price Order No. C. 522

WHEAT FLOUR

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Wilfred Jayasuriya, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order—

(i) revoke with effect from midnight of 11/12th January, 1973, the Food Price Order No. C. 507 dated 12th November, 1971, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,984/4 of 13th November, 1971;

(ii) fix with effect from midnight 11/12th January, 1973, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price and a retail dealer's maximum retail price to a consumer, respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the Municipal Limits of the Town of Colombo;

- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any articles specified in column 1 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the date of the sale,
 - (b) the quantity of such article sold (by weight),
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold,
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.

Food Price Order No. 523

WHITE REFINED SUGAR

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Wilfred Jayasuriya, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from midnight of 11/12th January, 1973, the Food Price Order No. C 520 dated 16th December 1972, published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* of the Republic of Sri Lanka (Ceylon) No. 38/6 of 18th December, 1972.
 - (ii) fix with effect from midnight of 11/12th January, 1973, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett, to a consumer, respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the Island of Ceylon;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule, less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;

- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any articles specified in column 1 of the Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any articles specified in column 1 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the date of the sale,
 - (b) the quantity of such articles sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.

Order under Section 4

Food Price Order No. C. 521

BREAD

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Wilfred Jayasuriya, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from midnight of 11/12th January, 1973, the Food Price Order No. C. 508 dated 12th November, 1971, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 14,984/4 of 13th November, 1971;
- (ii) fix with effect from midnight of 11/12th January, 1973, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which bread shall not be sold in 16 oz. loaves and in 8 oz. loaves respectively within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii) direct that any loaf weighing more than 8 oz. or any part more than 8 oz. in weight of any loaf shall not be sold in any area at a price higher than the price calculated proportionately by weight from the maximum price per 16 oz. loaf fixed by this Order for that area;
- (iv) direct that any loaf weighing not more than 8 oz. or any part not more than 8 oz. in weight of any loaf shall not be sold in any area at a price higher than the price calculated proportionately by weight from the maximum price per 8 oz. loaf fixed by the Order for that area;
- (v) direct that when any bread is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper, if any, in which such bread is sold;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has bread in his possession at any premises, shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of bread;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any bread shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,
 - (b) the description of the loaf sold,
 - (c) the quantity of bread sold, and
 - (d) the price paid for the bread sold;
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "oz." shall be deemed to be the standard ounce avoirdupois weight.
