Rule

The rules made by the Ceylon Railway Guards' and Locomotive Enginemen's Provident Association, and deemed to be rules made under section 8 of the Ceylon Railway Guards' and Locomotive Enginemen's Provident Association (Incorporation) Act, by virtue of section 8 (4) of that Act, are further amended as follows:—

(1) under Chapter II—

(a) in rule 1 (a) by the substitution for the expression "Rs. 5" of the expression "Rs. 10";

(b) by the substitution, for paragraphs (c) and (d) of rule 2, of the following new paragraphs:—

"(c) On the retirement from the State service of any member of the Corporation, who has contributed regularly to the funds of the Corporation in accordance with these rules for a period of not less than one year, a donation calculated in the following manner shall be paid to such member in addition to the payment referred to in paragraph (a),

(i) total donation paid up to the date of retirement, plus

(ii) percentage of all the total donations paid by such member. The percentage shall be calculated by doubling the period of membership in the Association over hundred, $D. \times 2 P$

100

D. stands for the amount donated,
P. stands for period of membership.

(d) on the death of any member of the Corporation, or in the event of any member retiring from service as a result of an accident whilst on duty, a donation of Rs. 3,000 shall be paid to such member or his family, provided he has completed one year's membership in the Association."

(c) by the substitution, for rule 3, of the following new rule:—

"3. A donation call of Rs. 60 per annum shall be recovered from every member liable to such calls in twelve monthly instalments of Rs. 5 and the amount so recovered shall be credited to the Donation Reserve Fund, which would meet donations paid under rule 2 (c) and (d).";

(d) by the substitution, for paragraph (a) of rule 7, of the following new paragraph:—
