All communications relating to Trade Marks should be addressed to the Registrar of Trade Marks, Department of the Registrar of Companies, Block 5, Echelon Square, Colombo 1.

Hours of Inspection

The office shall be open to the public on every working day between the hours ten to four, and on every half day between the hours ten to one.

Applications for inspection will, however, be accepted up to 3 p.m. on working days and 12 noon on half days.

Trade Marks limited to Colour

Where it is stated in the advertisement of an application that the mark upon its registration is to be limited to

certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible, indicated in the accompanying representation of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.

Association

Where it is stated that an advertised mark is to be associated under Section 22 of the Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap. 121) with another mark, it is indicated by its official number.

Application in Part A or Part B

Applications for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number

OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has ground of objection to the registration of the following Trade Mark may, within two months from the date of this *Gazette*, lodge Notice of Opposition on form T.M. No. 7 bearing an uncancelled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expenses of preparing the Notice of Opposition are incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

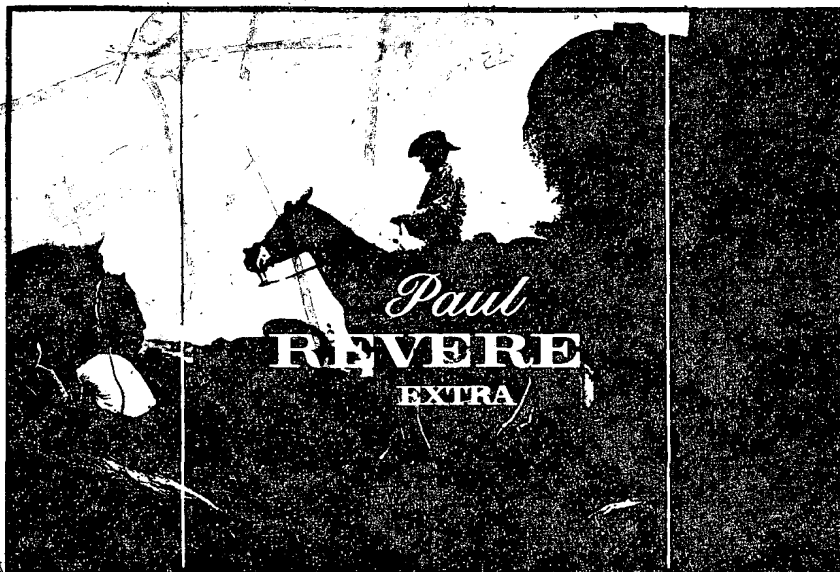

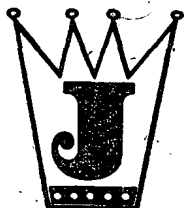

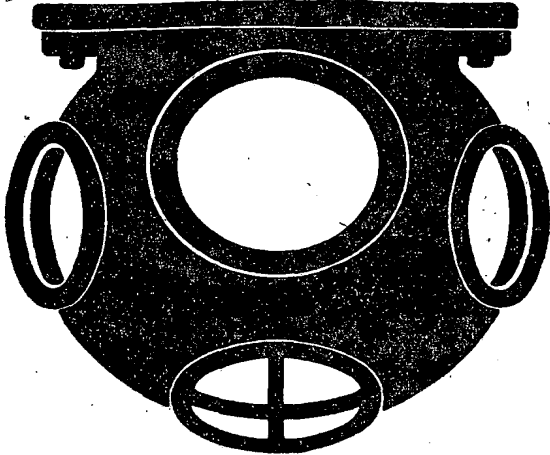

1. All Notices and Advertisements are published at the risk of the Advertisers.
2. All Notices and Advertisements by Private Advertisers may be handed in or sent direct by post together with full payment to the Government Printer, Government Press, Colombo.
3. The office hours are from 8 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays and 8 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. on other days.
4. Cash transactions close at 11 a.m. on Saturdays and 2.00 p.m. on other days.
5. All Notices and Advertisements must be prepaid. Notices and Advertisements sent direct by post should be accompanied by Money order, Postal order or Cheque, made payable to the Government Printer. Postage stamps will not be accepted in payment of advertisements.
6. To avoid errors and delay "copy" should be on one side of the paper only and preferably typewritten.
7. All signatures should be repeated in block letters below the written signature.
8. Notices *re* change of name from Non-Government Servants and Trade Advertisements are not accepted for publication.
