1. These regulations may be cited as the Navy (Delegation of Commanding Officer's Powers) Regulations, 1973.

2. A commanding officer of a ship or establishment of the Navy may, except in the cases which are expressly required by the Navy Act to be tried by a court-martial, delegate in writing his power of dealing summarily with an offender to any officer under his command in accordance with the succeeding provisions.

3. All action pertaining to such delegation and the period during which such delegation shall remain in force shall be subject to the written concurrence of the Captain of the Navy.

4. An officer to whom power is delegated by a commanding officer under regulation 2 may try and punish a seaman who has committed any non-capital naval offence but so however that—

(1) If the officer to whom power is delegated is of the rank of Lieutenant-Commander or of higher rank, such officer shall not have the power to award imprisonment or detention for a period exceeding two months;

(2) if the officer to whom power is delegated is of the rank of Lieutenant or of lower rank, such officer shall not have the power to award imprisonment or detention for a period exceeding two weeks.

5. Where a commanding officer has delegated his powers in accordance with the provisions of these regulations, he may in writing, withdraw such delegated power at any time.

3. The expression "1st year of employment" in paragraph 2 of this determination, in respect of employment under any employer means the period of 12 consecutive months commencing on the date on which an employee first took employment under that employer.

4. For the purpose of this determination—

- (1) "salesman" means a person employed for the purpose of serving customers within the meaning of the Shop and Office Employees (Regulation of Employment and Remuneration) Act (Chapter 129);
- (2) "shop boy" means a person employed to perform sundry duties and includes a packer, a peon, messenger boy, a delivery boy, a counter boy, cycle boy and an orderly;
- (3) "clerk" means a person who is wholly or mainly employed on clerical work including typewriting and accounts;
- (4) "cashier" means a person who is wholly or mainly employed to receive and or pay money, have the custody of money, maintain such records and books as are necessary and attend to the banking of money when called upon to do so;
- (5) "telephone operator" means a person who is wholly or mainly employed to operate the telephone switch board, to make and receive telephone calls, to answer telephone inquiries and to maintain such records as are incidental thereto;
- (6) "storekeeper" means a person employed in charge of a store room where the bulk stores are kept and responsible for the maintenance of necessary books and records connected with such storekeeping; and
- (7) "labourer" means a person who is employed to perform any unskilled work.

## Award

The Honourable the Minister of Labour by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131, of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon (1956 Revised Edition), as amended by Acts Nos. 14 of 1957, 62 of 1957, 4 of 1962 and 39 of 1968 (read with Industrial Disputes (Special Provisions) Act No. 37 of 1968) has, by his Order dated 5.10.70, referred the above mentioned dispute to me for arbitration.

The matter in dispute between the aforesaid parties, is whether the transfer of Mr. S. K. Somasunderam (Head Kangany) from Leangolla Division to Lebanon Division of Lebanon Group, Madulkelle, is justified, and to what relief he is entitled.

This dispute was taken up for inquiry on several dates, but on 17.12.71, counsel for the Applicant Union confined the claim against the Respondent to one of gratuity only.

The position of the Respondent is that the estate on which the workman concerned worked came into the possession and ownership of the present proprietor on 1.1.56 and the workman concerned worked under the present owner from 1.1.56 to 1967. The Respondent was also agreeable to pay gratuity to the workman concerned for the period he worked under them, viz. from January, 1956 to 1967 and they denied liability to pay gratuity in respect of the period prior to 1.1.56. On 11.1.73, counsel for the Respondent led the evidence of one Kandiah and this witness marked a document R.1, viz. the deed of sale and in the deed of sale no mention has been made in respect of liabilities for past service of workers on the estate prior to 1.1.56. This witness also stated that they did not take over liabilities of the previous owners in respect of gratuities and other payments. Under cross-examination, this witness admitted that the estate was bought on 30th December, 1955 and when the present owner took over the estate on 1.1.56 the same workers continued to work on the estate and there was no break of service of the workers on the estate including the workman concerned in this dispute. This witness also admitted that according to the earlier records the workman concerned has worked on the estate from 1937. This witness further stated that in 1966 the average earnings of the workman was Rs. 65.15 and his pence money was Rs. 20.46 and the total salary was Rs. 85.61. The Respondent, on record stated that they were prepared to pay gratuity due to the workman for the period he worked under them after they bought the estate. It was also submitted that the workman concerned was entitled to provident fund benefits from 1959. It follows that only 2 years of service under the Respondent has not covered by the provident fund.

The question that this Tribunal has to decide is whether the present owner of the estate, viz. the Respondent to this dispute is liable to pay gratuity for the services of the workman under the previous owners. A deed of sale has been produced and the deed is silent in respect of the liabilities of the previous owners in respect of gratuity. In other words it does not provide specifically as to who is liable to pay gratuity for the past services before the sale. It has been urged by the counsel for the Respondent that on 30th December 1955, the services of all the workers, were terminated including the workman concerned and they were re-employed again on 1st January, 1956. The mere fact that there was re-employment of all the workers and the mere fact that the services of all the workers were terminated and the workers were taken into employment by the new owner, does not absolve the new owner's liability to pay gratuity for services rendered by these workers on the estate of the previous owners. If the previous owners have reserved the right to pay gratuity to these workers for service under the previous owners, it would have been clearly provided for on the deed which in fact today most of the deeds of sales provide

for. R.1 is silent as to the liability of payment of gratuity for workers before the sale. In the absence of such provisions, the liability to pay for the past services under the previous owners falls on the new owner, the Respondent to this dispute. The witness Kandiah who gave evidence stated that gratuity has been paid by the former owners, but no evidence of payment has been led except his mere statement that gratuity had been paid and it is clear that the workman concerned was in continuous employment on the own admission of the Respondent from 1937. This Tribunal comes to finding that the present owners are liable to pay gratuity to the workman concerned in respect of service on the estate before they purchased the estate from the previous owners. The witness Kandiah stated that from the records that are available on the estate, the workman concerned was a worker on the estate from 1937. It follows that from 1937 to 1955, for 18 years of service on the estate, no provident fund benefits were provided for the workman, for the reason that the Provident Fund Act came into operation

only in 1959. It is in evidence that the workman's total salary was in the region of Rs. 85 per month. Having regard to the circumstances of this dispute, I hold that the Respondent to this dispute is liable to pay gratuity for the past services of the workman concerned for 18 years. Accordingly I order the Respondent to pay gratuity for 18 years of service at one month's salary for each year of service at Rs. 85 per month. On this basis the workman concerned is entitled to a sum of Rs. 1,530. The Respondent shall deposit the sum of Rs. 1,530 with the Assistant Commissioner of Labour, Kandy within one month from the publication of this award.
